Ladies back or front Jumper



Why should children have all the fun!

This jumper can be worn back to front so you can mix up your colour choices or use an ombre yarn and choose which way to wear it!

what you will need

5mm (H) hook (or testing 4mm hook and 6 mm hook) needle for sewing in ends stitch markers

Red heart super saver ombre or like yarn to obtain gauge 2 full balls and part of a 3rd. (440 meters per ball)

(15 stitches x 9 rows of DC = 4inches using 5mm hook) Scissors

Stitches used (U.S Terminology)

Chain (ch)

Back Bump of starting chain

Slip Stitch (slst)

Double Crochet (DC)

Front Post Double Crochet (FPDC)

Back Post Double Crochet (BPDC)

Double Crochet Two Together (DC2Tog)

Half Double Crochet (HDC)

Single Crochet (sc)

Mattress Stitch

invisible join

Ch 184

R1. DC into back bump of 3rd chain from the hook and each back bump to end (182 dc and 1 ch2)

*chain 2 does not count as a stitch here or anywhere throughout the pattern.

This first row is the right side of your work, place a stitch marker around one of the DC posts facing outward. Bring together each end of your work with the stitch marker still facing outward,

join to the first DC with a slip stitch forming a circle, taking care not to twist. leave stitch marker in position facing outward (do not remove)

using the tail from beginning row join to secure 1st and last chain at base.

From here we will be working in the round forming the bottom band of the jumper.

ch 2 turn.

R2. FPDC, BPDC to end of round, slst to 1st fpdc. ch2 turn

R3. FPDC, BPDC to end of round, slst to 1st fpdc. ch2 turn

R4 FPDC, BPDC to end of round, slst to 1st fpdc. ch2 turn.

R5. FPDC, BPDC to end of round, slst to 1st fpdc. Ch2 turn

R6. FPDC, BPDC to end of round, slst to 1st fpdc. Ch2 turn

Main body.

R6. DC to end of round, (182 DC) slst to 1st DC. ch2 turn.

R7. DC to end of round,(182 DC) slst to 1st DC. ch2 turn.

continue with R6 and R7 until you have a total of 28 DC rounds.

do not fasten off

The turning/ joining seam for the main body will now become a side seam as you continue on making the front and back of the jumper.

Front of jumper.

Row 1. DC 91 stitches, place a stitch marker in 92nd stitch, ch1 (marked stitch will be starting point for back of jumper)

**chain 1 does not count as a stitch here or anywhere throughout pattern

Row 2. turn work DC 91 stitches ch1
Row 3. turn work DC 91 stitches ch1
continue with row 3 until you have a total of 15 rows
Row 16 Turn work DC 30 stitches, ch1
Row 17 Turn work DC 30 stitches. Fasten off.

Leave a length of yarn long enough to use to sew shoulders when finishing.

Repeat row 16 and row 17 at other end beginning 30 stitches in from the end of row 15.

Back of the jumper.

starting at the marked stitch

Row 1. attach yarn in marked stitch ch1 DC in same stitch and remaining 90 unworked stitches from main body

Row 2. ch1 turn work DC 91 stitches ch1

Row 3. turn work DC 91 stitches ch1 continue with row 3 until you have a total of 15 rows Row 16 Turn work DC 30 stitches, ch1 Row 17 Turn work DC 30 stitches. Fasten off.

Leave a length of yarn long enough to use to sew shoulders when finishing.

Repeat row 16 and row 17 at other end beginning 30 stitches in from the end of row 15.

Sewing shoulders.

Turn work inside out.

using stitch markers join front and back at top in the 1st stitch and 30th stitch on each side. These will form shoulders and neck opening.
using yarn tails from left and right edge sew using mattress stitch from 1st to 30th stitch

marker.

leave stitch markers in 30th stitch positions (you will use these stitches when making neck band)

Turn work back right way out before beginning sleeves.

Sleeves

Starting at the bottom of the armhole, evenly space 64DC st around.

Slip st to first st, ch1 turn.

R2 64 dc around slst to 1st dc, ch1 turn

R3 64 dc around slst to 1st dc, ch1 turn

Repeat R3 until you have completed 9 rounds.(64dc)

R10 dc2tog, dc around, slst to1st dc, ch1 turn (63)

R11 63 dc around slst to 1st dc, ch1 turn

R12 dc around to last 2 st, dc2tog (62)slst to1st dc, ch1 turn

R13 62 dc around slst to 1st dc, ch1 turn

R14 dc2tog, dc around to last 2 st, dc2tog. (60)slst to1st dc, ch1 turn

R15 60dc around slst to 1st dc, ch1 turn

R16 dc2tog, dc around to last 2 st, dc2tog. (58)slst to1st dc, ch1 turn

R17 58 dc around slst to 1st dc, ch1 turn

R18 dc2tog, dc around to last 2 st, dc2tog. (56)slst to1st dc, ch1 turn

R19 56 dc around slst to 1st dc, ch1 turn

R20 dc2tog, dc around to last 2 st, dc2tog. (54)slst to1st dc, ch1 turn

R21 54 dc around slst to 1st dc, ch1 turn

R22 dc2tog, dc around to last 2 st, dc2tog. (52)slst to1st dc, ch1 turn

R23 52 dc around slst to 1st dc, ch1 turn

R24 dc2tog, dc around to last 2 st, dc2tog. (50)slst to1st dc, ch1 turn

R25 50 dc around slst to 1st dc, ch1 turn

R26 dc2tog, dc2tog, dc around to last 4 st, dc2tog, dc2tog(46)slst to1st dc, ch1 turn

R27 46 dc around slst to 1st dc, ch1 turn

R28 dc2tog, dc2tog, dc around to last 4 st, dc2tog, dc2tog(42)slst to1st dc, ch1 turn

R29 42 dc around slst to 1st dc, ch1 turn

R30 dc2tog, dc2tog, dc around to last 4 st, dc2tog, dc2tog(38)slst to1st dc, ch1 turn

R31 38 dc around slst to 1st dc, ch1 do not turn.

R32 fpdc, bpdc, fpdc, bpdc repeat around finishing with a bpdc. Slst to 1st fpdc, ch1 turn

R33 fpdc, bpdc, fpdc, bpdc repeat around finishing with a bpdc. Slst to 1st fpdc, ch1 turn

R34 and R35 repeat round 33

R36 sc around (38sc) finish with an invisible join.

Repeat sleeve for other armhole.

Finishing neck

Join yarn with a Slip stitch into the first double crochet before the 30th dc of shoulder hdc into the same st.

place 2 hdc in each of the dc along shoulder edge (8 in total)

Hdc 32 st, place 2 hdc in each of the dc along shoulder edge (8 in total)
Hdc 32st join with a slst to first hdc.ch1, do not turn
Single crochet in each stitch around, finish with an invisible join. Sew in all ends.
