01 - Leaf



02 - Flower

The flower consists of big petals (A - pink yarn) and middle part (B - orange yarn).



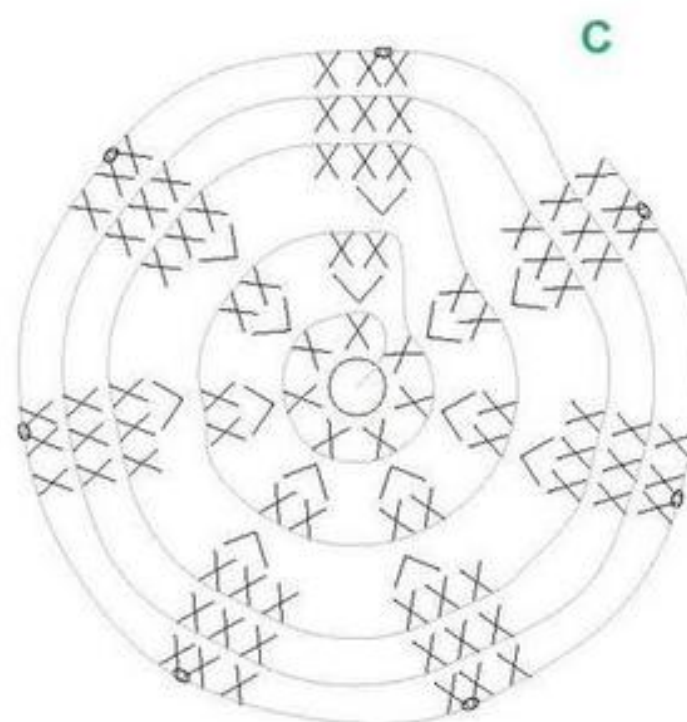
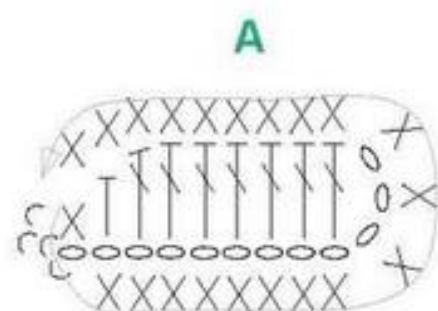
03 - Flower

The flower consists of big petals (A), 2 middle parts (B and C).

Work with diagram A - **two** rounds of petals (white yarn). For one round make 8 petals (for each next petal make 12 ch and work given stitches - see diagram). The last petal connects to first by sl.st.

For middle part 1 work with diagram B (green yarn).

For middle part 2 work in spiral with diagram C (yellow yarn). At the end of work fill the middle part with absorbent cotton.

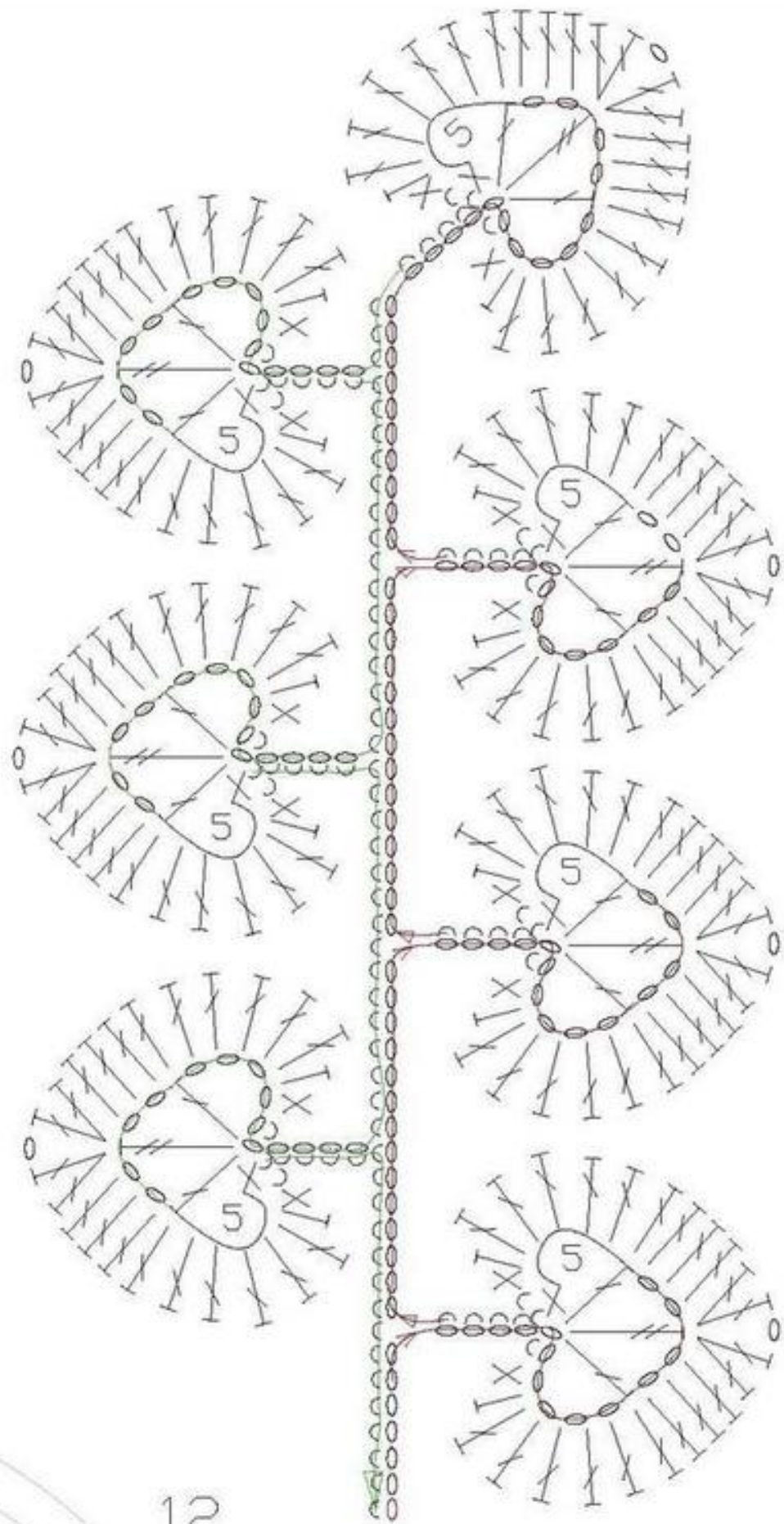
Make chain foundation of 7 chs.

For leaf work:

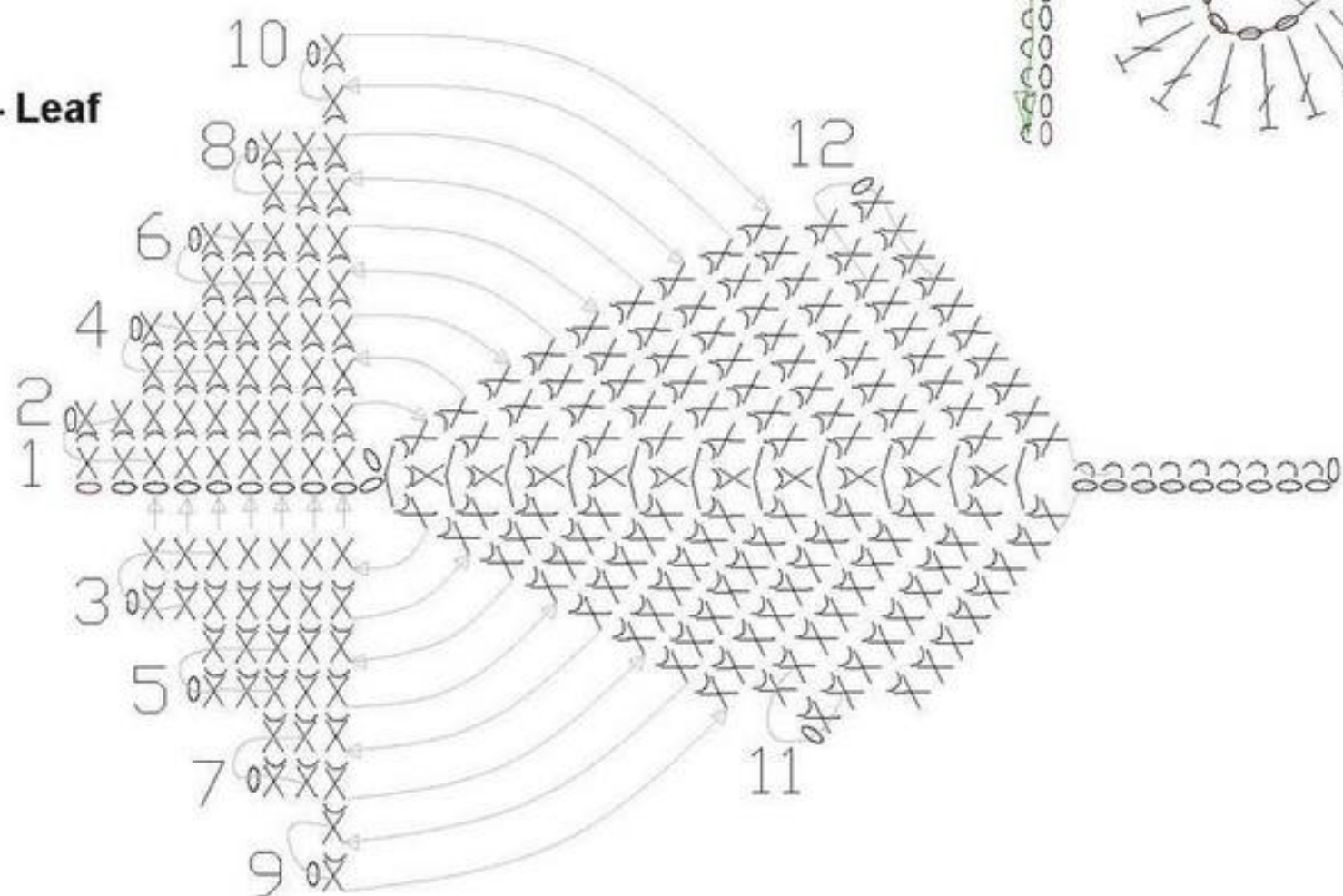
10 ch, 1 tr/dc in 6ch from hook, 2ch, 1 d.tr/tr - 2 ch - 1 tr/dc - 5 ch - 1 dc/sc - sl.st in the same ch. Work 2nd round: sl.st - dc.sc - h.tr/h.dc - 5tr/dc in first arch of 5 ch, 1tr/dc in tr/dc below, 3 tr/dc in arch of 2 ch, 2 tr/dc - 1ch - 2 tr/dc in d.tr/tr below, 3 tr/dc in next arch of 2ch, 1tr/dc in tr/dc below, 5 tr/dc - h.tr/h. - dc /sc in arch of 5 ch, sl.st in dc/sc below, then work 5 sl.st in next 5 ch.

For next leaf work 14 ch and repeat first leaf. After you get a 3 leaves work leaf on top of branch: make 10 ch and repeat first leaf. Work on oposite side with sl.st and continue make leaves (see diagram).

For middle part 2 work in spiral with diagram C. At the end of work fill the middle part with absorbent cotton.

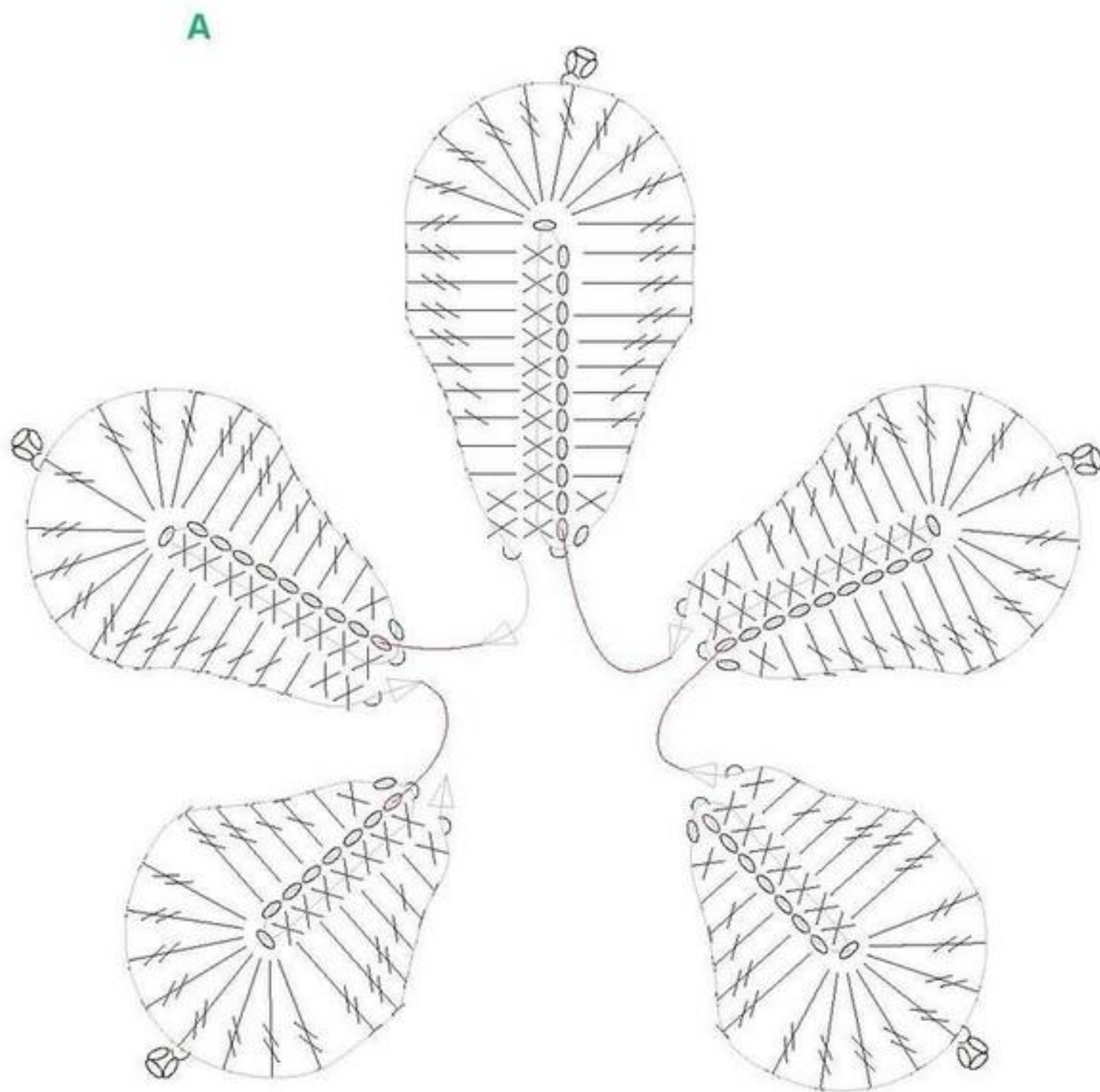

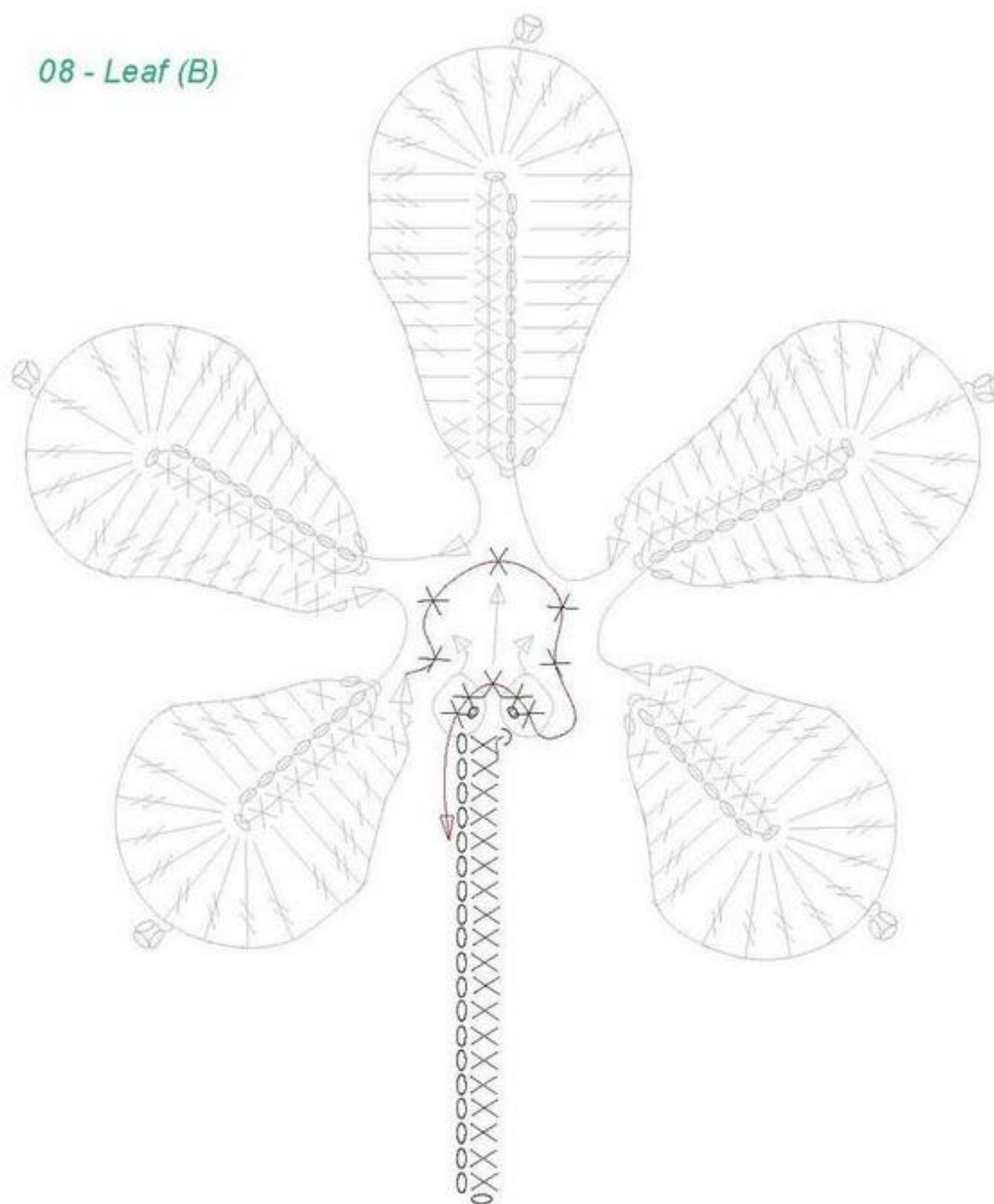
For the first leaf make chain foundation of 8 ch (A), work dc/sc in 2nd ch from hook and dc/sc in each stitch of chain foundation. At the end work sl/st in last ch, 1 ch, continue work on opposite side. In each stitch work dc/sc, h.tr/h/dc, 2 tr/dc, 2 d.tr/tr, 5 d.tr/tr - picot of 3 ch - 3 d.tr/tr in the same stitch, in dc/sc below work 3 d.tr/tr, 2 tr/dc, h.tr/h.dc, dc/sc - sl.st in the same stitch.

Work in this way next leaf. Make chain foundation of 10 ch, work with diagram.

After you get 5 leaves work a base of steam (B - see on p.31). For the base work 1 dc/sc in the end of all leaves, than turn and work: 1 dc/sc decrease, 1 dc/sc, 1 dc/sc decrease.

Than work steam: make chain foundation of 20ch, work dc/sc and sl.st at the end (see diagram).

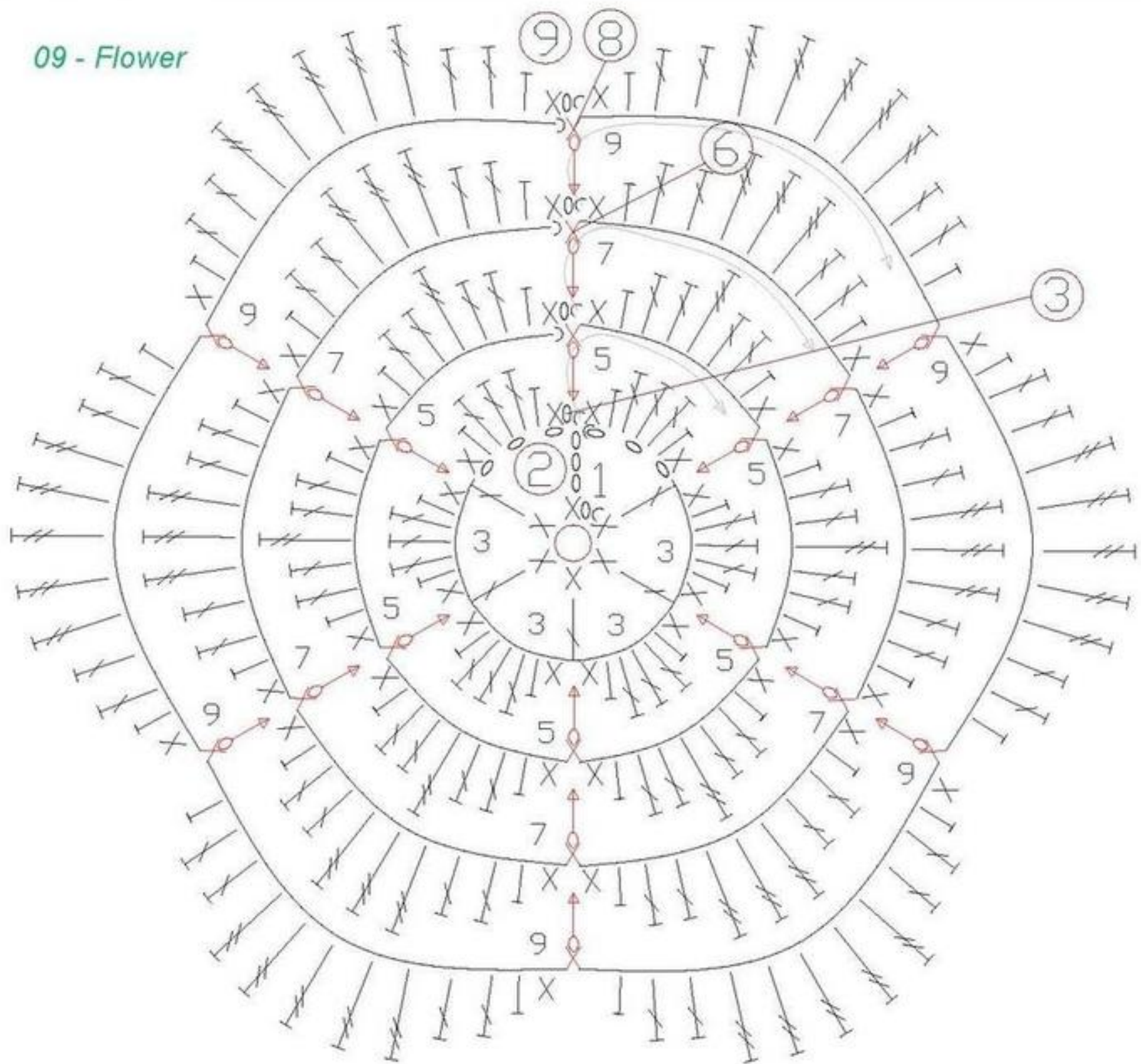

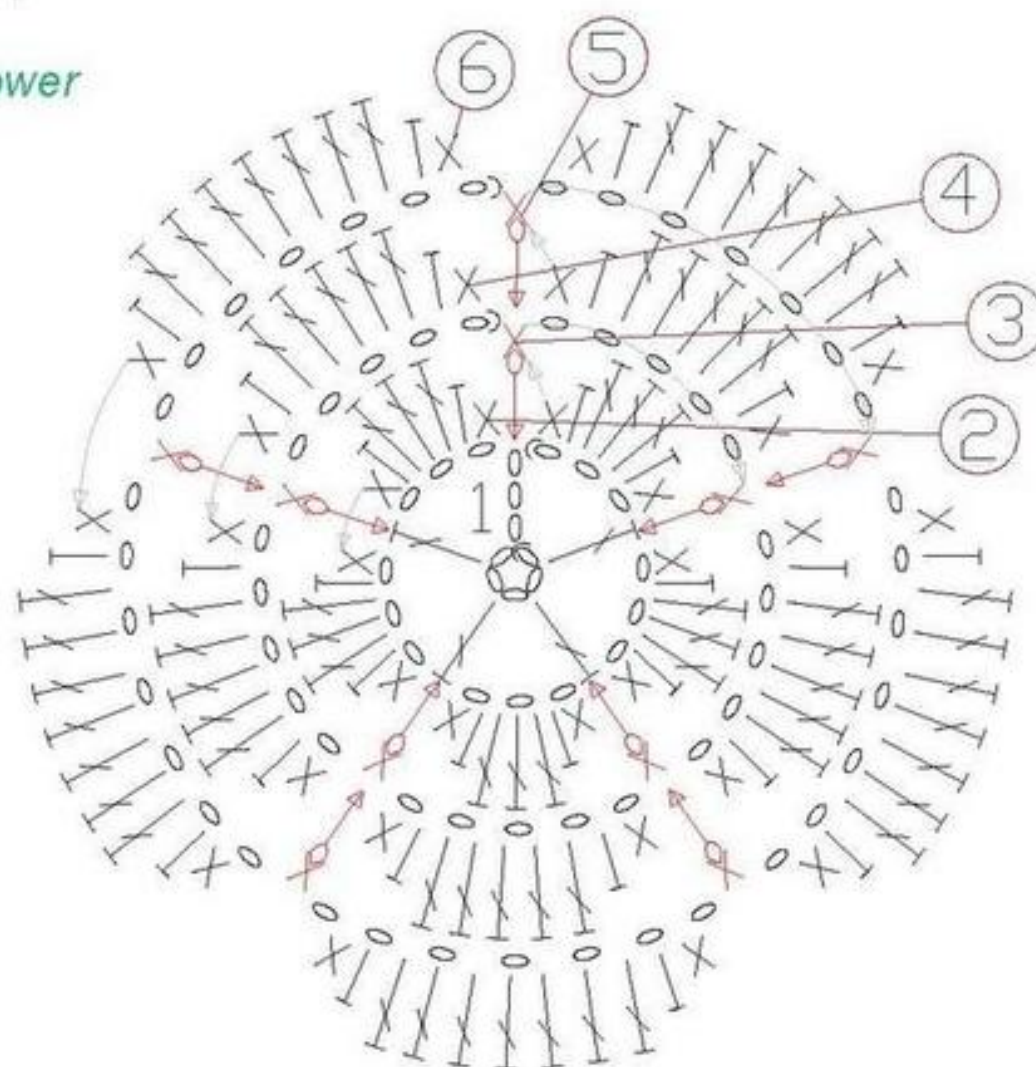

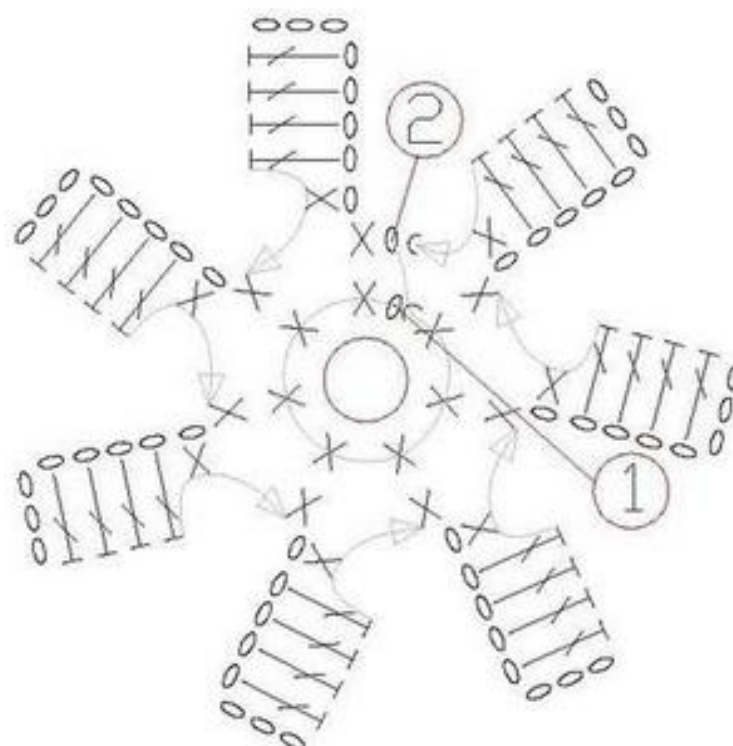

The work begins with chain foundation of 20ch for stem + 11ch for first leaf. Work dc/sc in 2nd ch from hook and 8dc/sc in next stitches, 1 dc/sc - 2 sl.st in last ch of leaf's chain foundation, turn and work on opposite side. Skip one st, dc/sc, h.tr/h.dc, 6tr/dc, h.tr/h.dc, 3dc/sc in first ch of leaf's chain foundation; work on opposite side: h.tr/h.dc, 6tr/dc, h.tr/h.dc, 1 dc/sc, sl.st, turn. In next row work dc/sc in back loop of each stitch and 3dc/sc in top of leaf, turn and work next row in this way (see diagram). At the end work make sl.st in first dc/sc.

For next leaf make chain foundation of 7 ch for stem and 11 ch for leaf, make next leaves like first. After you get 6 leaves, work on opposite side of branch with sl.st and make leaves.

1 round work with yellow yarn, 2 round - with pink yarn.

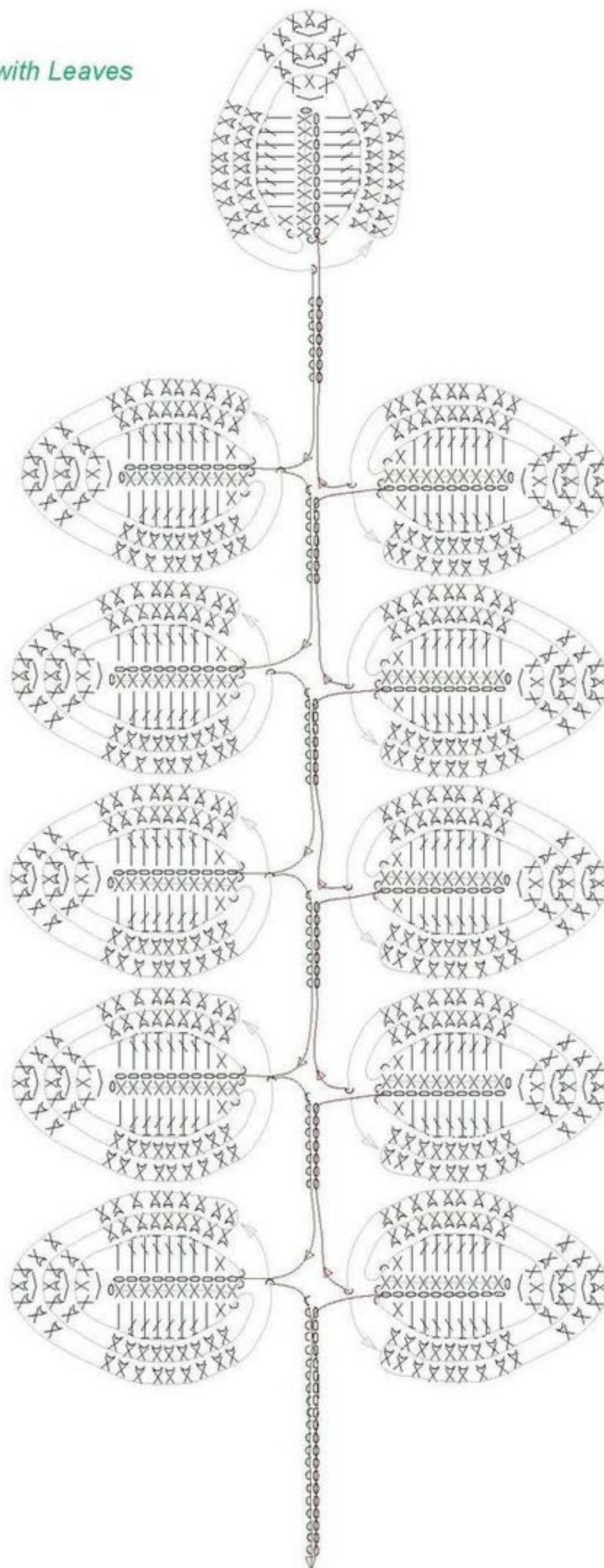

The work begins with chain foundation of 20 ch for big steam + 5 ch for leaf steam +13 ch for first leaf. Work dc/sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next stitches h.tr/h.dc, 2 tr/dc, 4 d.tr/tr, 2 tr/dc, h.tr/h.dc, dc/sc - sl.st in the same st, 1 ch, work on opposite side, 1 st skip, *2 dc/sc and picot of 3ch, repeat from* 4 times, dc/sc, dc/sc - picot of 3 ch - dc/sc in top of leaf, dc/sc with picot in next st, * 2 dc/sc and picot, repeat from* 3 times, 3dc/sc, sl.st in dc.sc below; work 5 sl.st on 5 ch of leaf steam.

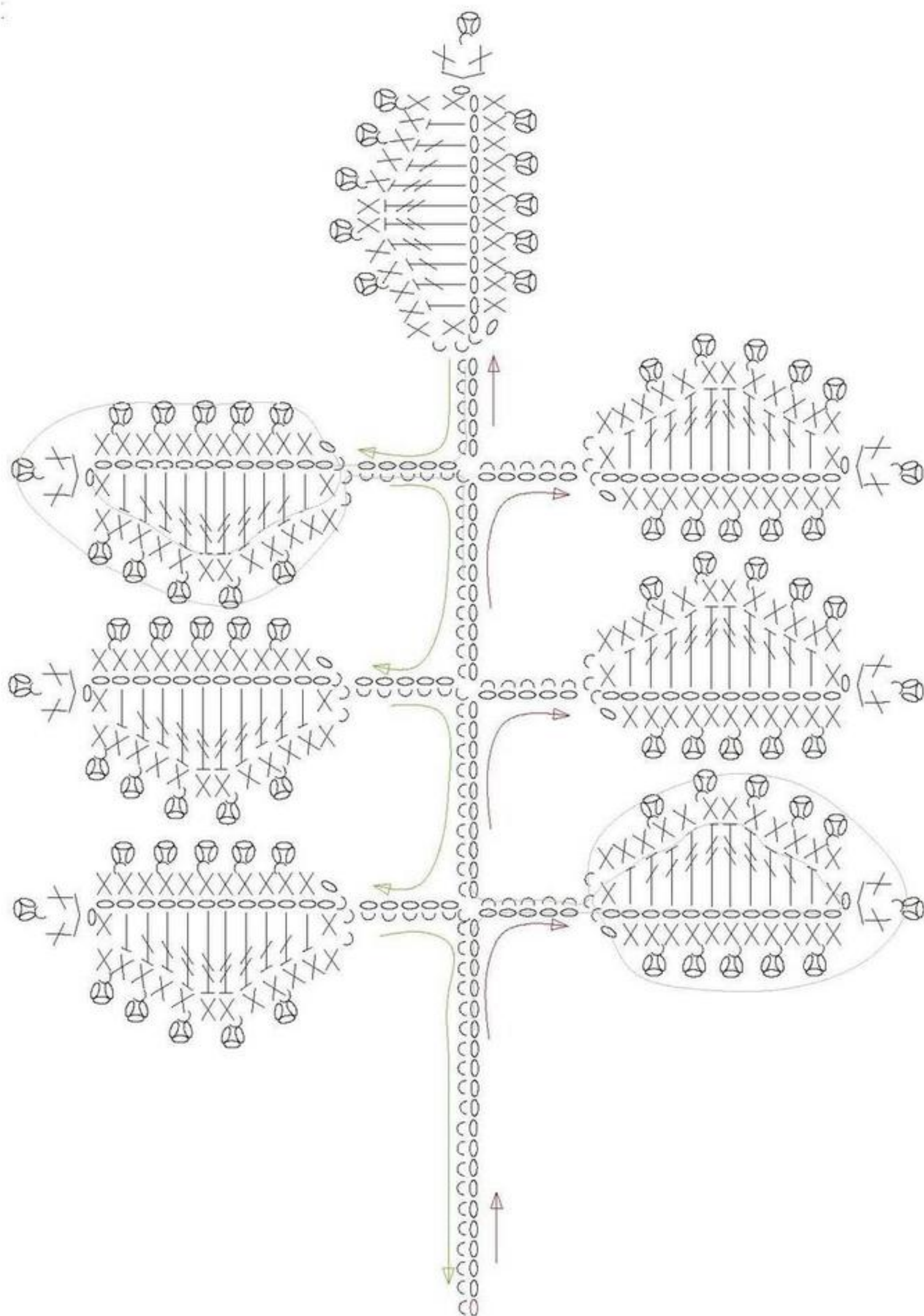
For next leaf work: chain foundation of 10 ch for big steam + 5 ch for leaf steam + 13 ch for next leaf. Make next leaves like first. After you get 3 leaves, work leaf on top of branch. For that leaf make 5 ch for leaf stem +13 ch for top leaf.

After top leaf work on opposite side of branch with sl.st and make leaves in such manner (see diagram).

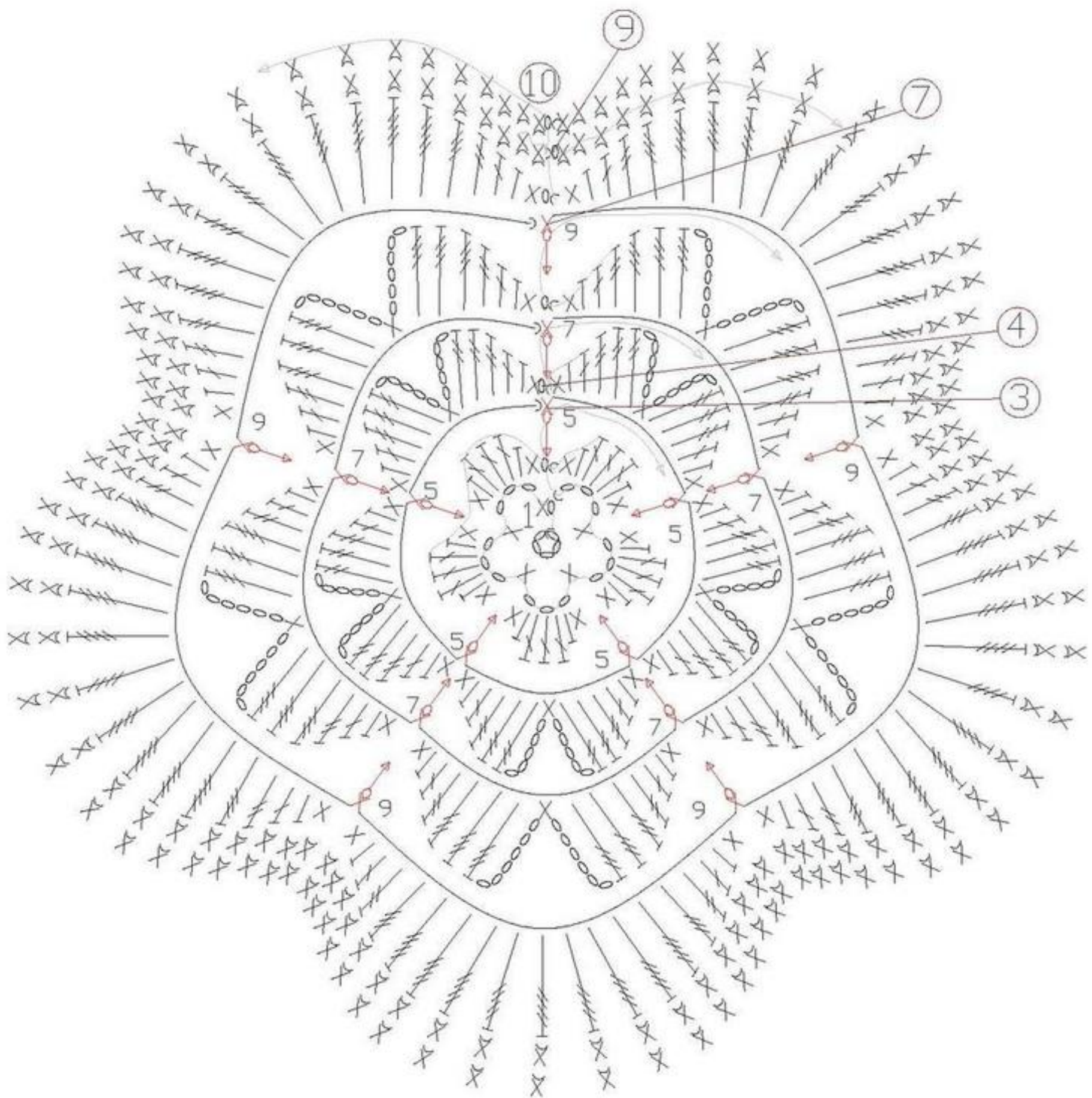


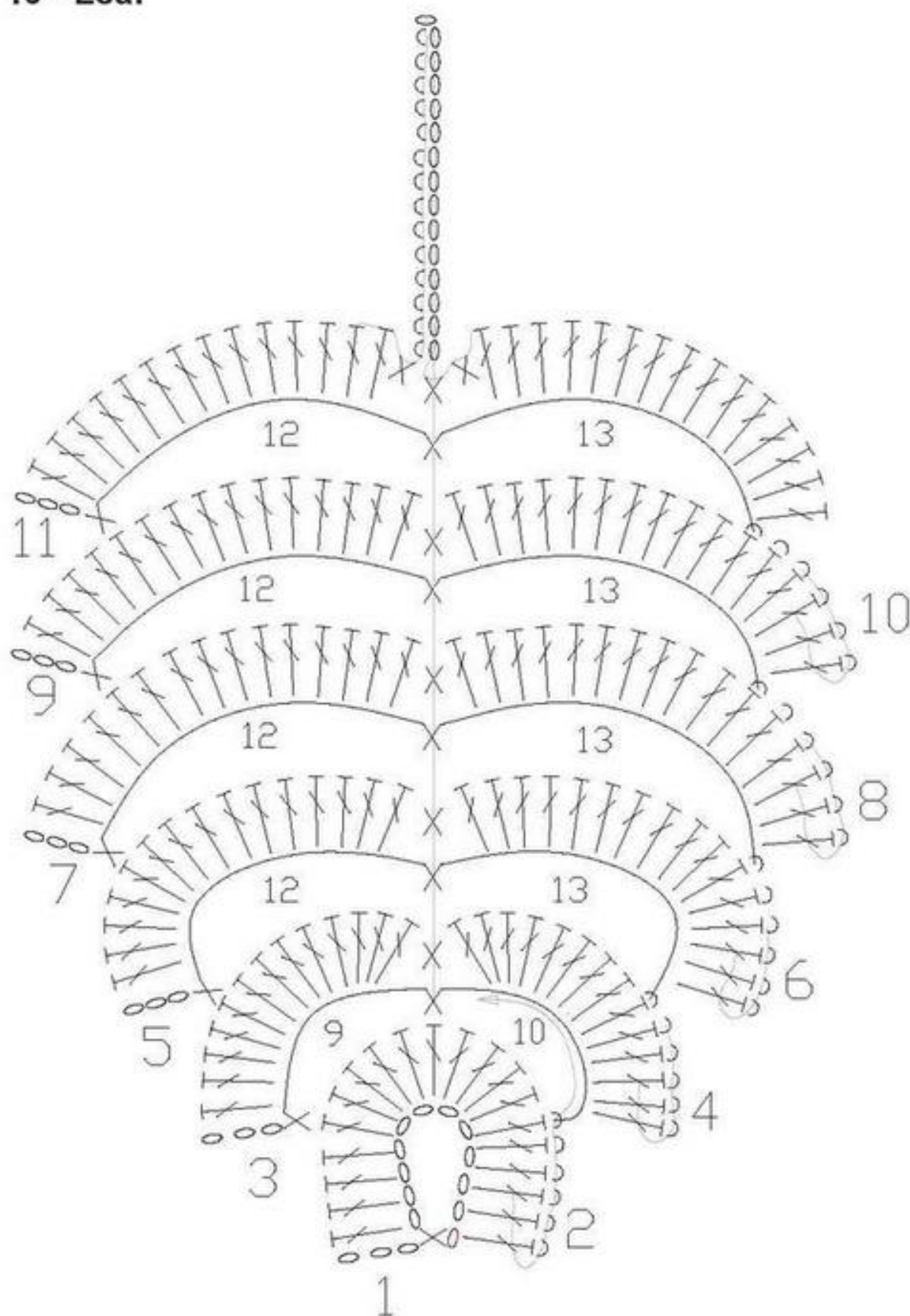
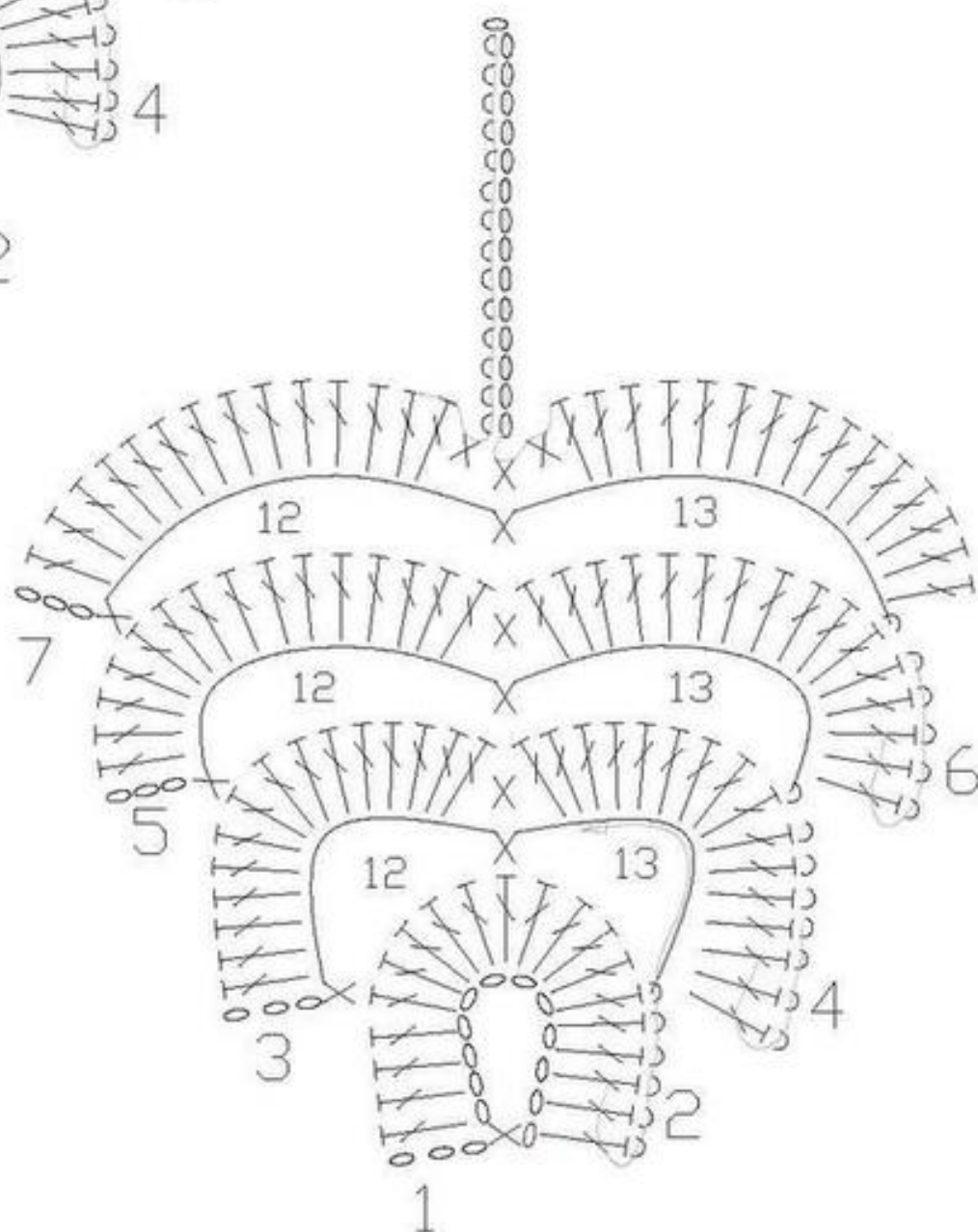

The work begins with chain foundation of 13 ch for big stem + 5 ch for leaf stem + 22 ch for first leaf. Work tr/dc in 7th ch from hook, * 2ch, 2st skip, tr/dc in next st, repeat from* 3 times, 2 ch, 2st skip and dc.sc and in next st. Work on opposite side: 3 dc/sc in first holl, *dc/sc in st, picot of 3 ch, 2dc/sc in next holl, repeat from*, 4 times; work on opposite side dc/sc - picot - 2dc/sc in the same holl, *dc.sc in tr/dc below, picot, 2dc/sc in next holl, repeat from*, 4 times, sl st in dc/sc below, than work sl,st in each st of 5 ch of stem.

For next leaf make chain foundation of 13 ch for big steam + 5 ch for leaf stem +22 ch for next leaf, make next leaves like first. After you get 4 leaves, work leaf on top of branch. For that leaf make 13 ch for big stem +22 ch for top leaf.

After top leaf work on opposite side of branch with sl.st and make leaves in such manner (see diagram).

18 - Flowers

See diagrams and pic. 1 on p.40.

Each bell work with diagram A (violet, orange and white yarn). Make a ring of 1ch, work 8dc/sc in ring, continue work spirally, in each dc/sc below work 2dc/sc 8 times, than work 80 dc.sc. Than make wide part of flower: 4ch, d.tr/tr in the same st, *3 d.tr/tr in the same st, repeat from *, 9 times, tr/dc, h.tr/h.dc, dc/sc, h.tr/h.dc, tr/dc, 2d.tr/tr in the same st, sl.st in 4th ch.

Flower sepals work with green yarn with diagram B. Insert hook between sts of first round, work dc/sc, 7ch, dc/sc in 2nd ch from hook, h.tr/h.dc, 4tr/dc, 1 dc/sc between stitches of 1st round. Continue in such manner until you get 5 sepals, work sl.st to first sepal and cutting yarn (see picture).

Stamens work with diagram C (yellow yarn). Stems work with diagram D (green yarn).

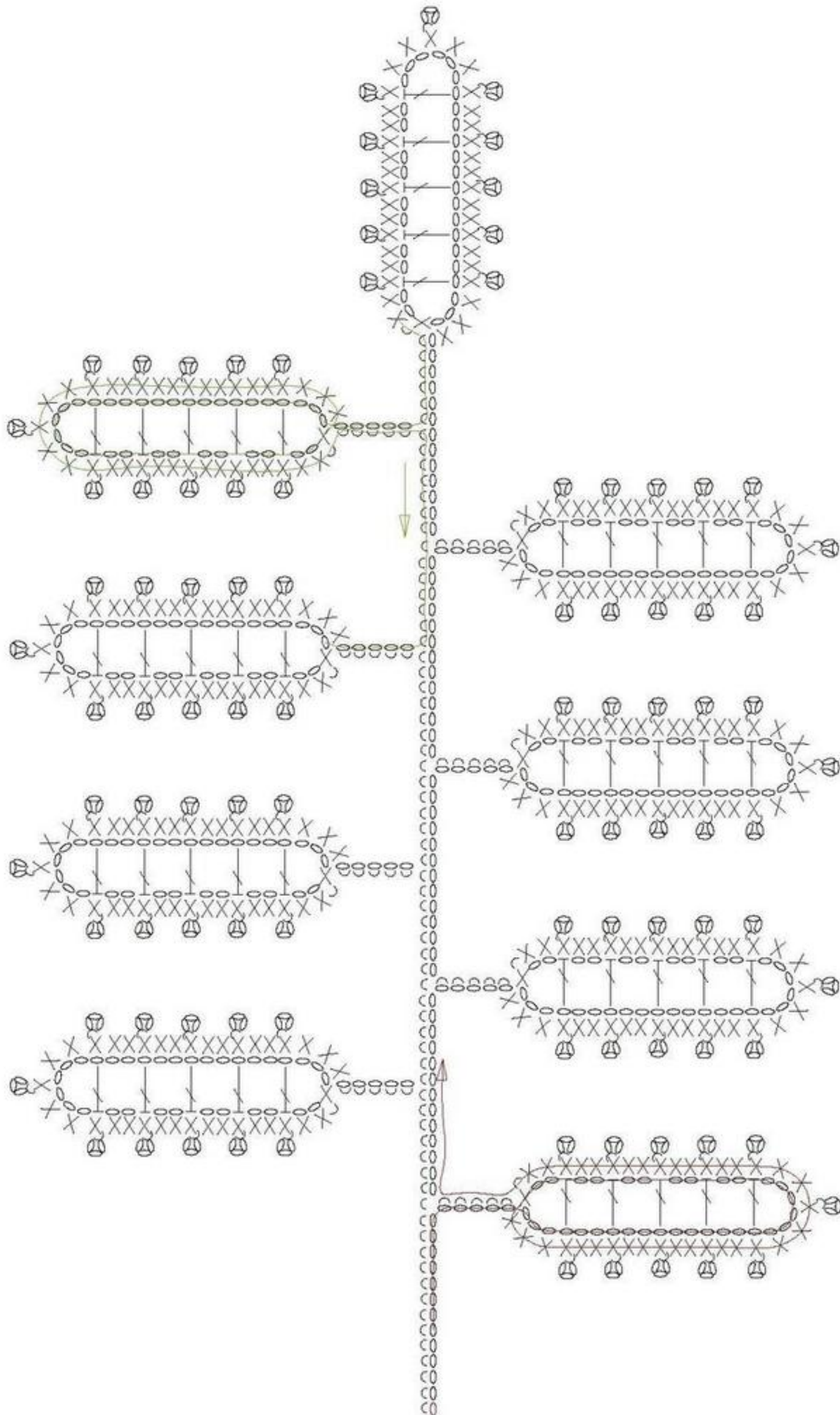

The flower consists of big petals (A) and middle part (B).

Petals work with pink yarn. For first petal work chain foundation of 10ch, make sl. st in 2nd st from hook, sl.sts to end. For next petal make 10 ch and work like first petal. Work in this way until you get 50 petals (see diagram A). Cut the yarn 20cm from edge. Use a needle to gather the base of flower (see pic.1).

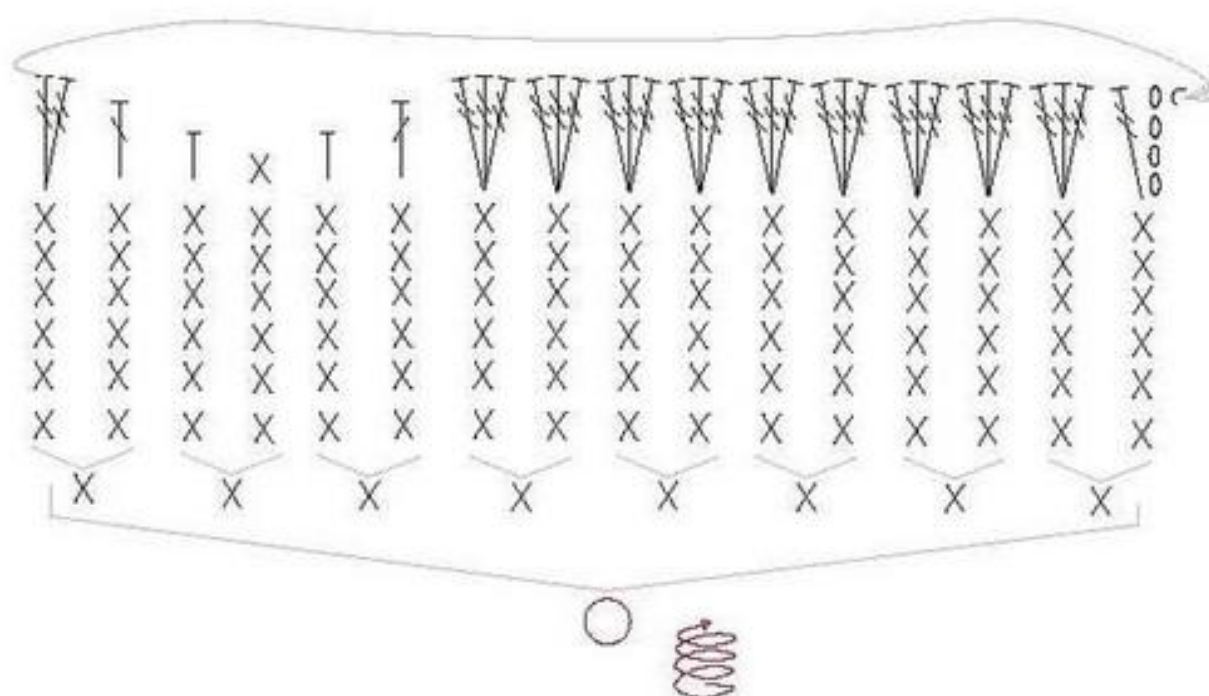

The work begins with chain foundation of 17 ch for stem + 10 ch for leaf. For first leaf work sl.st in 10th ch from hook, in space of 10ch work: dc/sc, h.tr/h.dc, 15tr/dc, h.tr/h.dc, dc.sc, sl.st in first dc/sc.

For next leaf make chain foundation of 6 ch for stem + 10 ch for leaf, make next leaves like first. After you get 5 leaves, work leaf on top of branch. For that leaf make 10 ch and work like first. Next leaf work like top leaf and work on opposite side. Work leaves and form stem with sl.sts (see diagram).

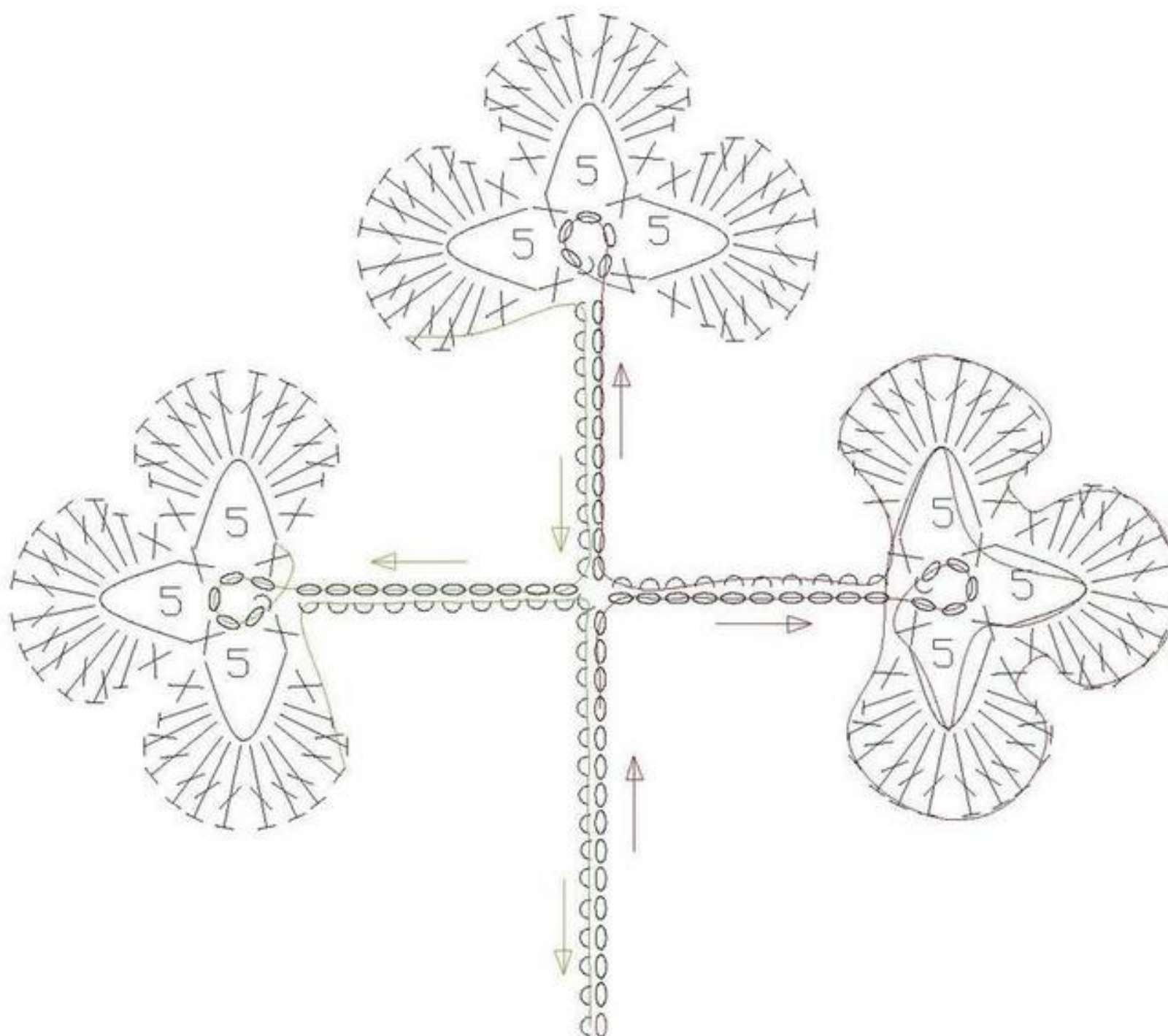
The work begins with chain foundation of 20 ch for stem + 10 ch for leaf. For first leaf work sl.st in 10th ch from hook, in space of 10ch work: dc/sc, h.tr/h.dc, 2tr/dc, 4d.tr/tr, 5ch, dc/sc, 5ch, 4d.tr/tr, 2tr/dc, h.tr/h.dc, dc.sc, sl.st.

For next leaf make chain foundation of 10 ch for stem + 10 ch for leaf, make next leaves like first. After you get 4 leaves, work leaf on top of branch. For that leaf make 10 ch and work like first. Next leaf work like top leaf and work on opposite side. Work leaves and form stem with sl.sts (see diagram).

24 - Branch with Leaves

The work begins with chain foundation of 15 ch for big stem + 10 ch for leaf's stem + 5ch for leaf. For first leaf work sl.st in 5th ch from hook, in space of 5ch work: dc.sc, * 5ch, dc/sc, repeat from*, 2 times. Work 2nd round: in each space of 5 ch: dc/sc, h.tr/h.dc, 10tr/dc, ,h.tr/h.dc, dc.sc. For leaf's stem work sl.st in each ch (10st).

For next leaf make chain foundation of 10 ch for leaf's stem + 5 ch for leaf, make next leaves like first. After you get 3 leaves, work big stem with sl.sts (see diagram).

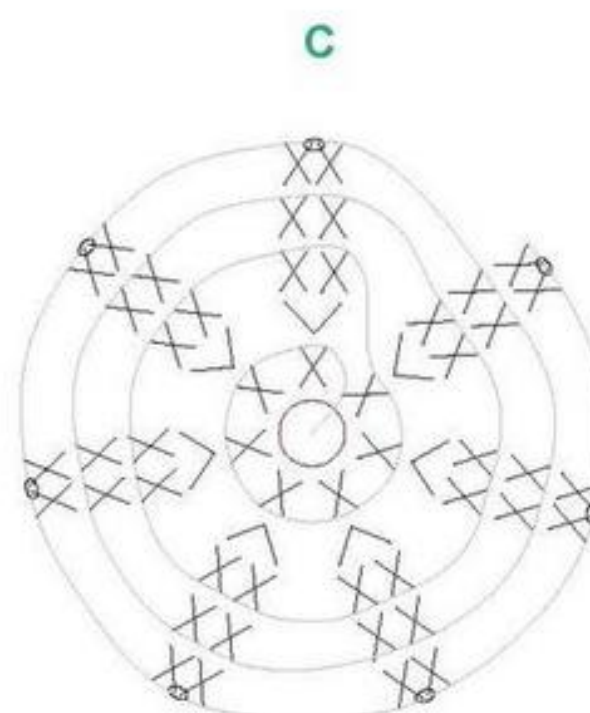
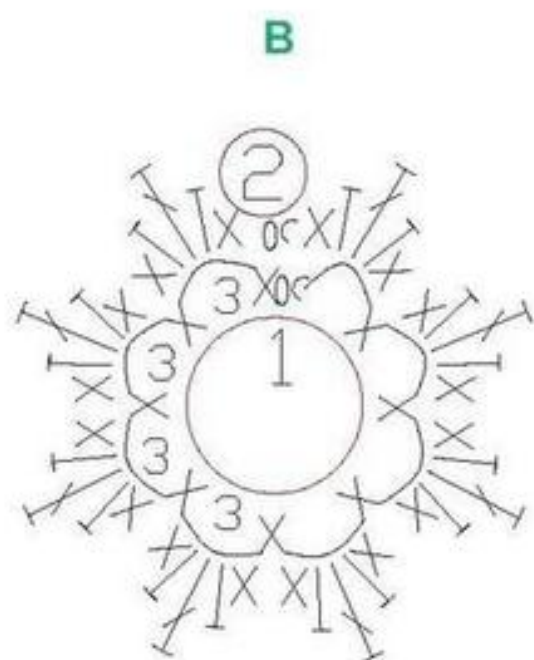
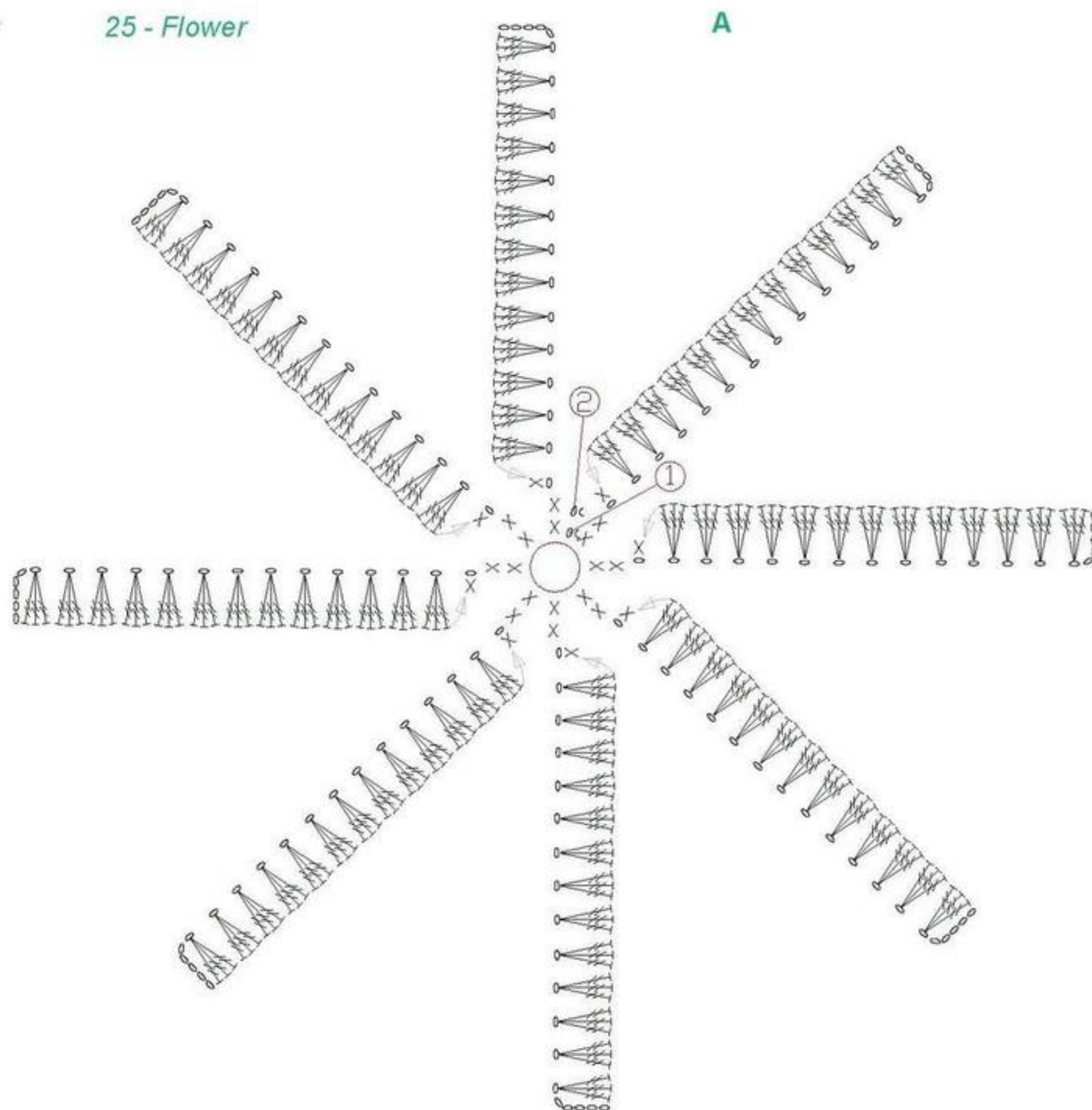

See diagram on p.48.

The work begins with chain foundation of 15 ch for stem + 14 ch for leaf. For first leaf work dc/sc in 2nd ch from hook, then work: h.tr/h.dc, 2tr/dc, 5d.tr/tr, 2tr/dc, h.tr/h.dc, dc.sc, turn. dc/sc in each st below, 3dc/sc in top of leaf, work on opposite side: *1ch, 1st skip, tr/dc in next, repeat from* 4 times, 1 ch, 2 dc/sc in last st of leaf, sl.st in first dc/sc, turn. Work dc/sc in back part of stitch below with 7 picots around the leaf (see diagram), sl.st in first dc/sc of this row.

For next leaf make chain foundation of 15 ch for stem + 14 ch for leaf, make next leaves like first. After you get 4 leaves, work leaf on top of branch. For that leaf make 14 ch and work like first. Next leaf work like top leaf and work on opposite side. Work leaves and form the stem with dc/sc (see diagram).

27 - Branch with Leaves

See diagram on p.49.

Work chain foundation of 20ch for stem + 8ch for first leaf. Work: dc/sc in 2nd ch from hook and dc/sc in each stitch of leaf's chain foundation (7st). At the end work sl/st in last ch and 1 ch, continue work on opposite side. In each stitch work dc/sc, h.tr/h/dc, 2 tr/dc, 2d.tr/tr, 5 d/tr/tr - picot of 3 ch - 3 d.tr/tr in the same stitch, in dc/sc below work 3d.tr/tr, 2 tr/dc, h.tr/h.dc, dc/sc - sl.st in the same stitch.

For next leaf make chain foundation of 8 ch for stem + 8 ch for leaf, make next leaves like first. After you get 3 small leaves, work one medium leaf, then work leaf on top of branch. For that leaf make 4 ch for stem and 12 for leaf. Work on opposite side next medium leaf, than 3 small leaves. Form the stem with sl.st (see diagram).

28 - Flower

The work begins with ring of chain foundation of 7ch.

Orange yarn.

1 round: 1ch, 12dc/sc in ring of 7ch, sl.st in ch.

2 round: 1ch, dc/sc, *1 st skip, 5ch and dc/sc in next st, 1st skip, 9ch and dc/sc in next stitch, repeat from*, 2 times, sl.st in ch.

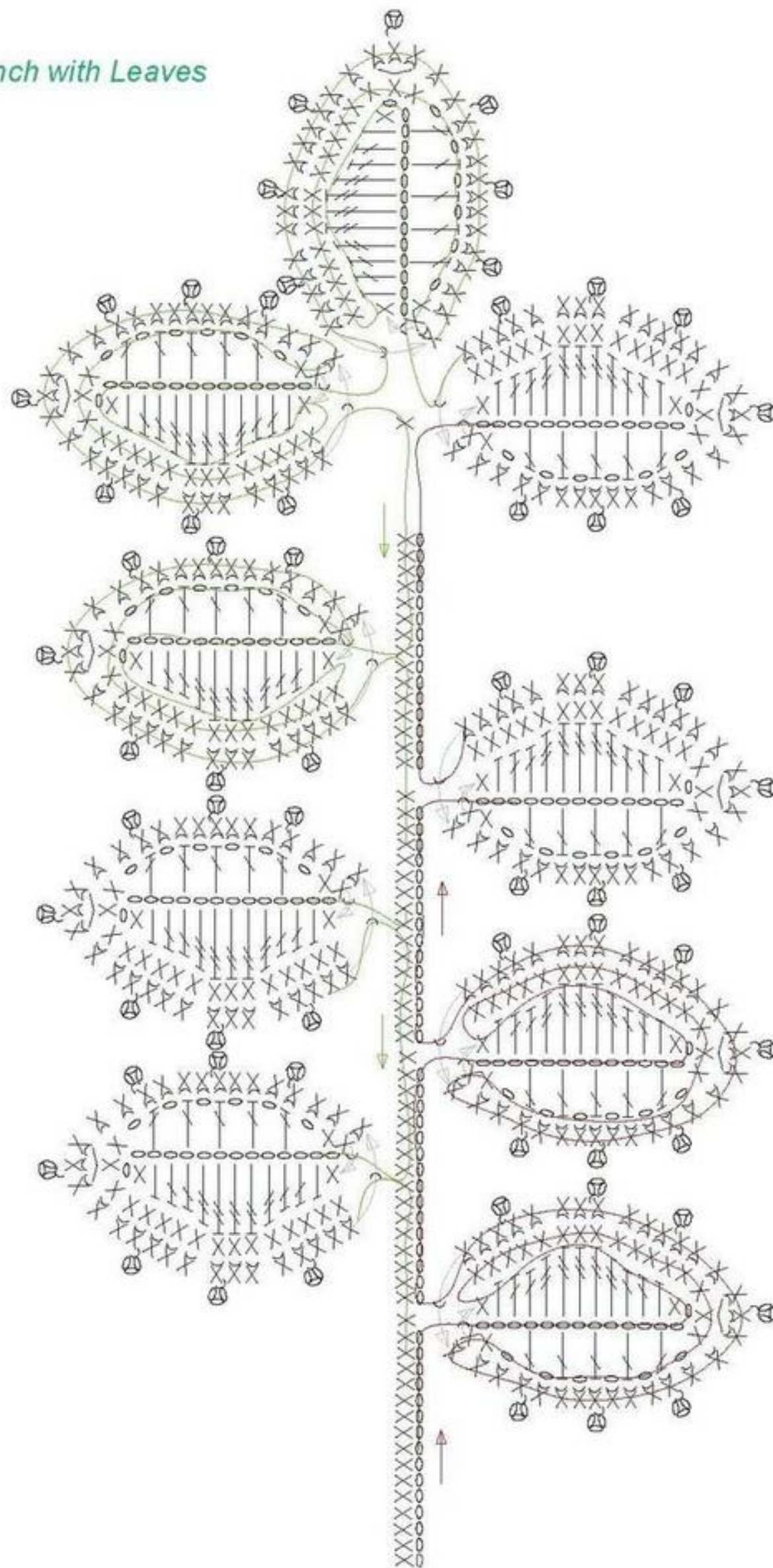
Pink yarn.

3 round: work only with arch of 5 ch. Work in each arch: (for first arch -1ch), dc/sc, h.tr/h.dc, 7tr/dc, h.tr/h.dc, dc/sc, sl.st in ch.

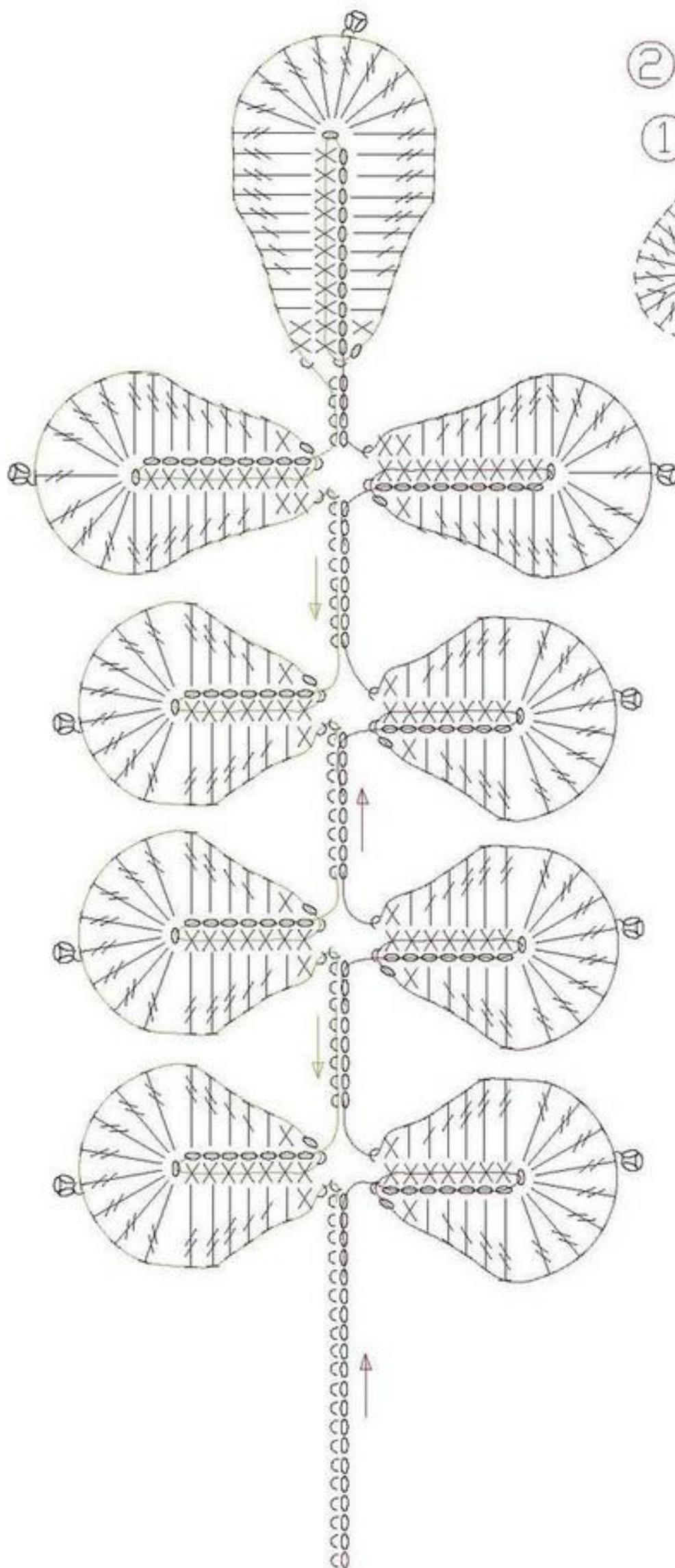
Dark pink yarn.

4 round: attach the thread to dc/sc of first round in space of 5ch (see diagram), 1ch and dc/sc, 21 tr/dc in arch of 9 ch, dc/sc in next dc/sc of first round in space of 5 ch, continue in this way work 21 dc/tr in each arch of 9 ch, at the end work sl.st to 1ch.

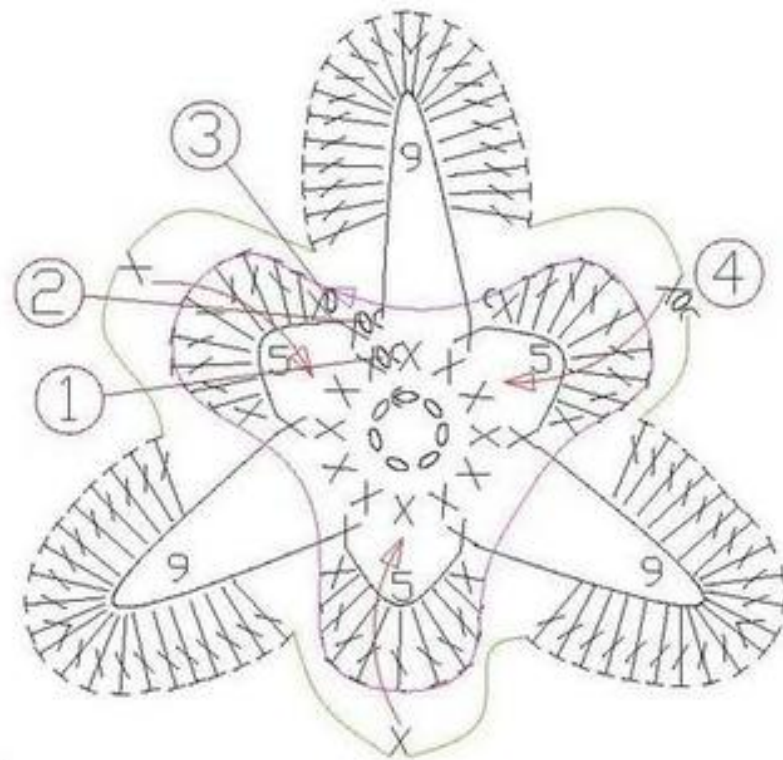

The bouquet consists of 3 branches with bells and pot.

Work bells with diagrams A - E: 2 light blue and 1 dark blue bells with diagram A, 2 dark blue and 1 light blue with diagram B, 2 light blue and 1 dark blue bells with diagram C, 2 dark blue and 1 light blue with diagram D, 2 light blue and 1 dark blue bells with diagram E.

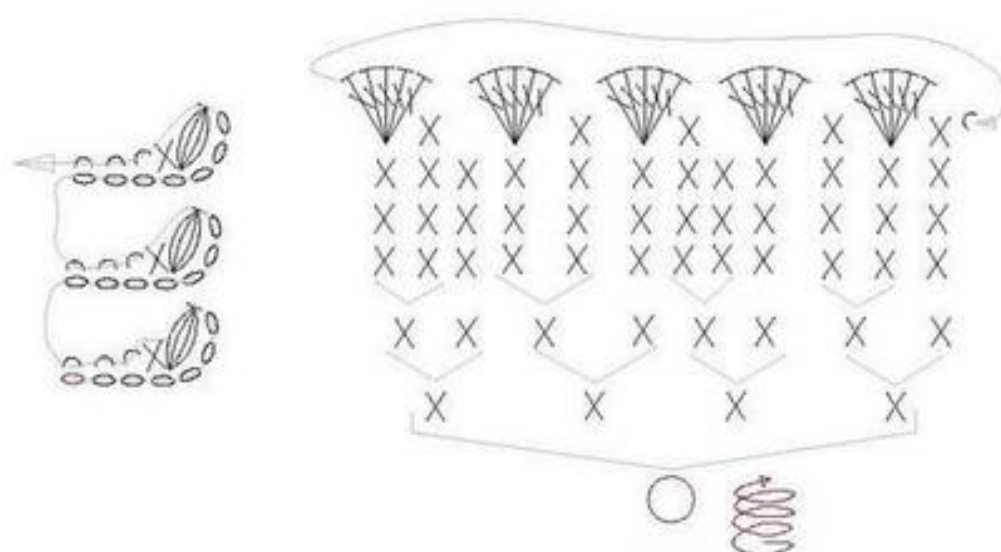
Work stamens with yellow yarn for each bell. Wrap the absorbent cotton around stamens and fill bells.

Stems work with diagrams F and G. Work 2 stems with diagram G (left - with light blue bells and right - with dark blue bells) and 1 stem with diagram F (middle branch). Places where bells connected to stems are shown with blue arrows.

64 - Bouquet with branches of Berries

See diagrams on p.81 - 84.

The bouquet consist of big flower, small flower, flower bud with stem, small stem, 7 blue flowers, 3 branches of berries and 7 leaves.

For big flower work with diagrams A, B and F. Work: 5 big petals with diagram A, 5 small petals with diagram B (white yarn) and stamens with diagram F (yellow yarn). For stamens work:

chain foundation of 40 ch. tr/dc in 4th ch from hook, * 1ch tr/dc in next st, repeate from* 35 times. In next row, work with diagram F, repeat part in green braket 35 times.

For small flower work 5 petals with diagram C (white yarn) and stamens with diagram F (yellow yarn). For stamens work chain foundation of 15ch, repeat part in green braket 10 times.

Flower bud with stem work with diagrams D (white yran), E and G (green yarn).

Bud's petal work with diagram D, then fold petal strip in two and work dc/sc at once in two edges. When the edges will be closed in half, fill the bud with absorbent cotton and continue work dc/sc to the end.

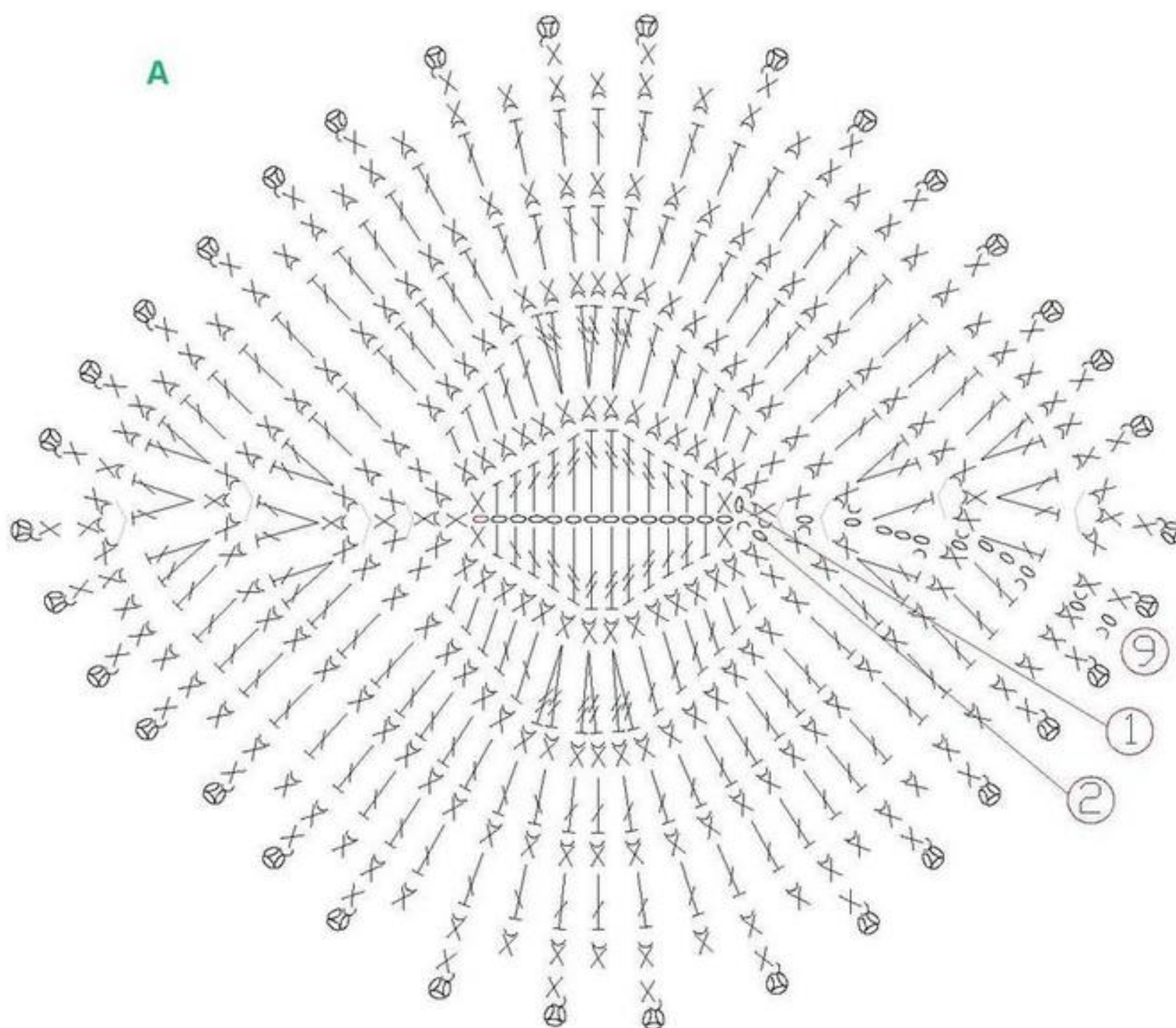
Work bud's sepal with diagram E and stem with diagram G, connect stem to sepal by dc/sc.

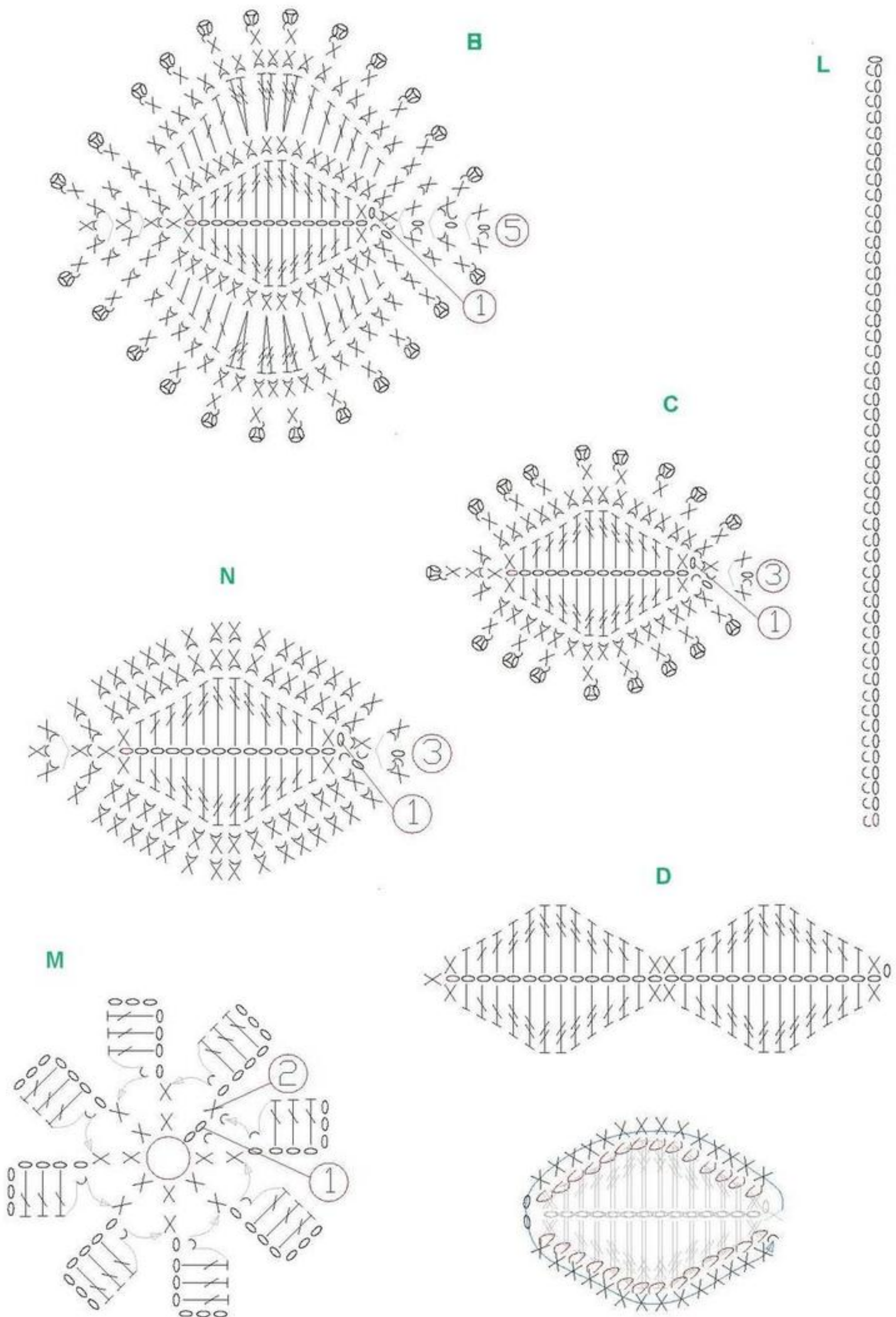
Work branches of berries with diagram J (red yarn) and K (light green yarn). Each of berries before decreasing fill with absorbent cotton and continue work. Connect branches to berries by dc/sc.

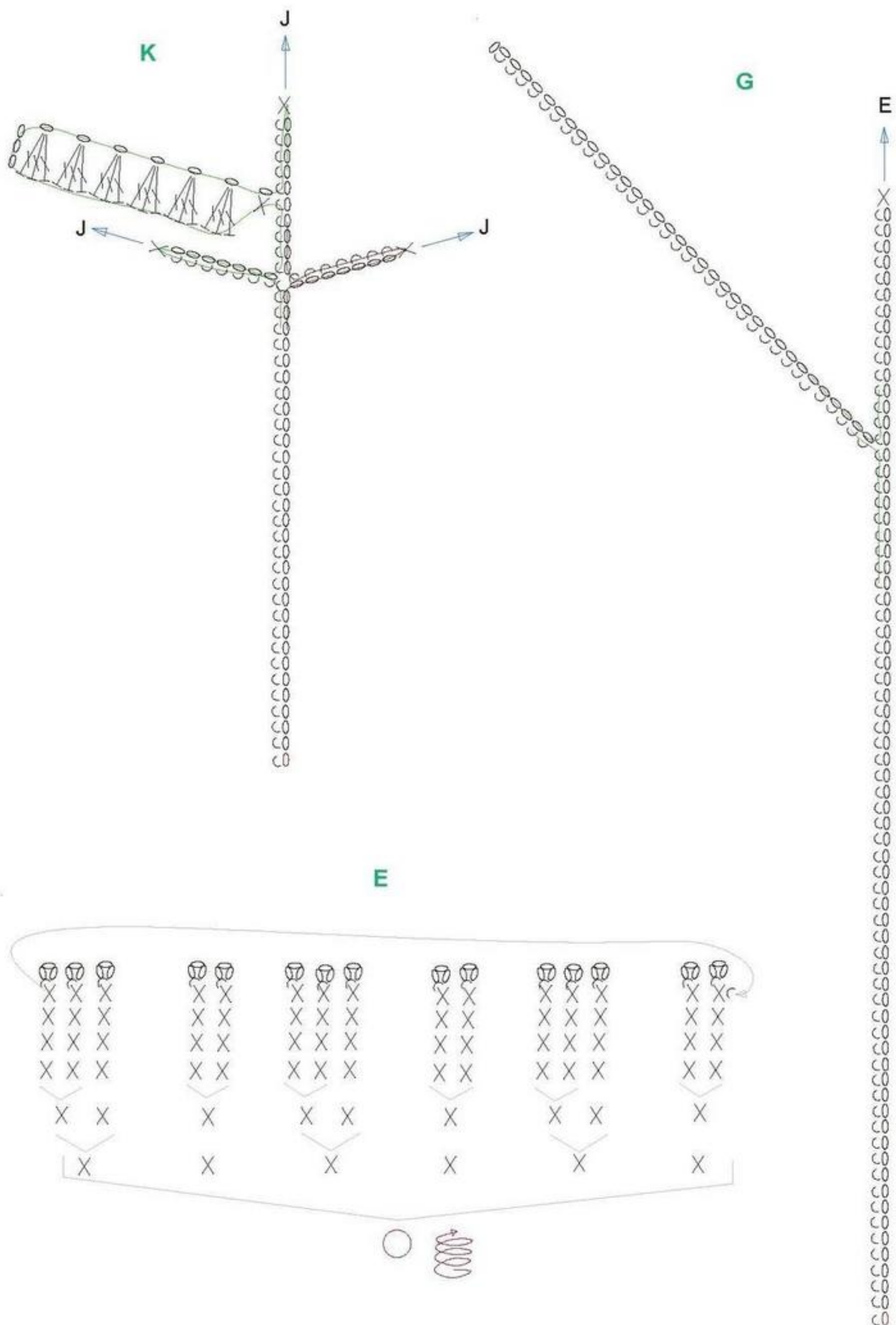

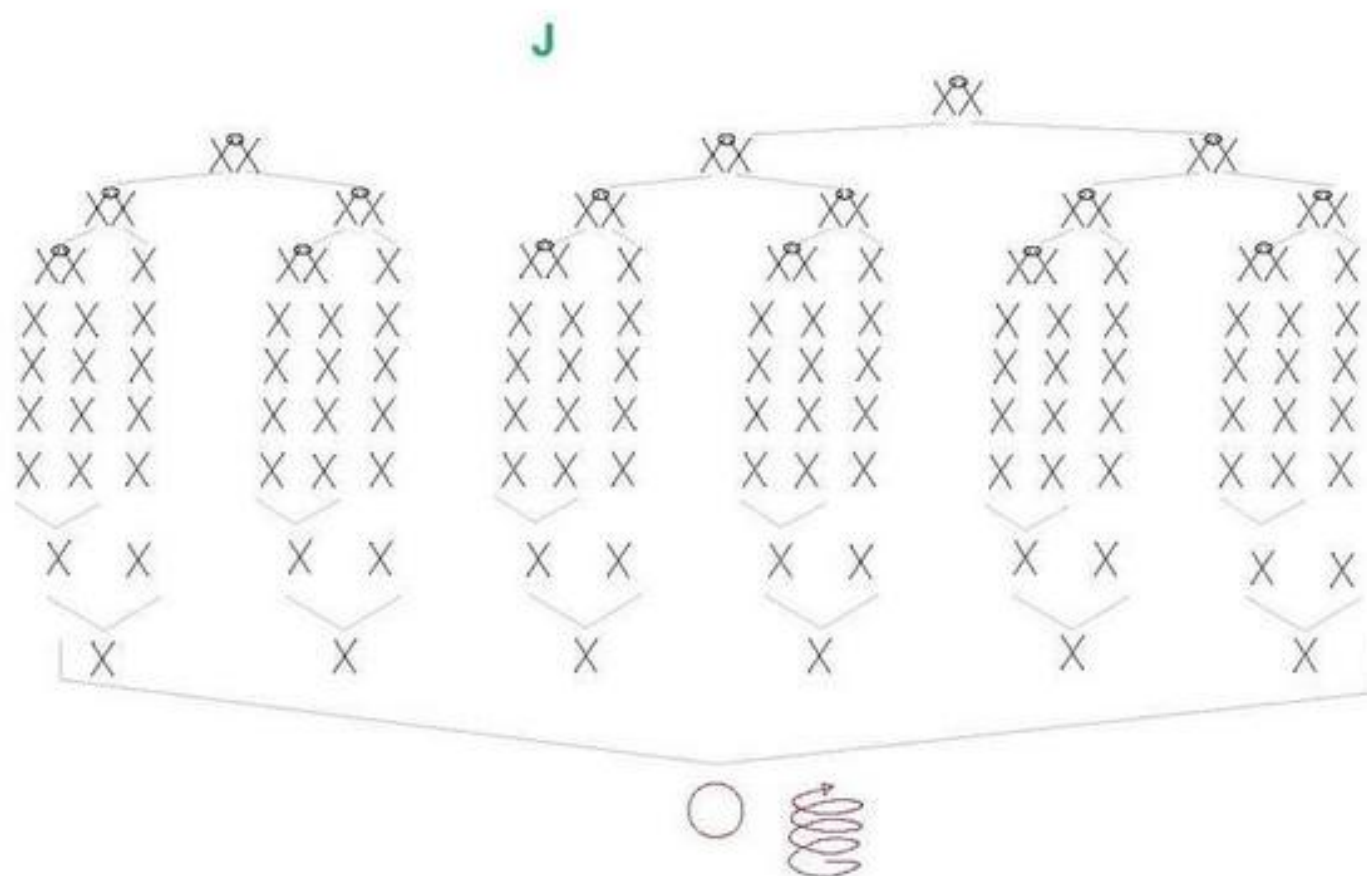
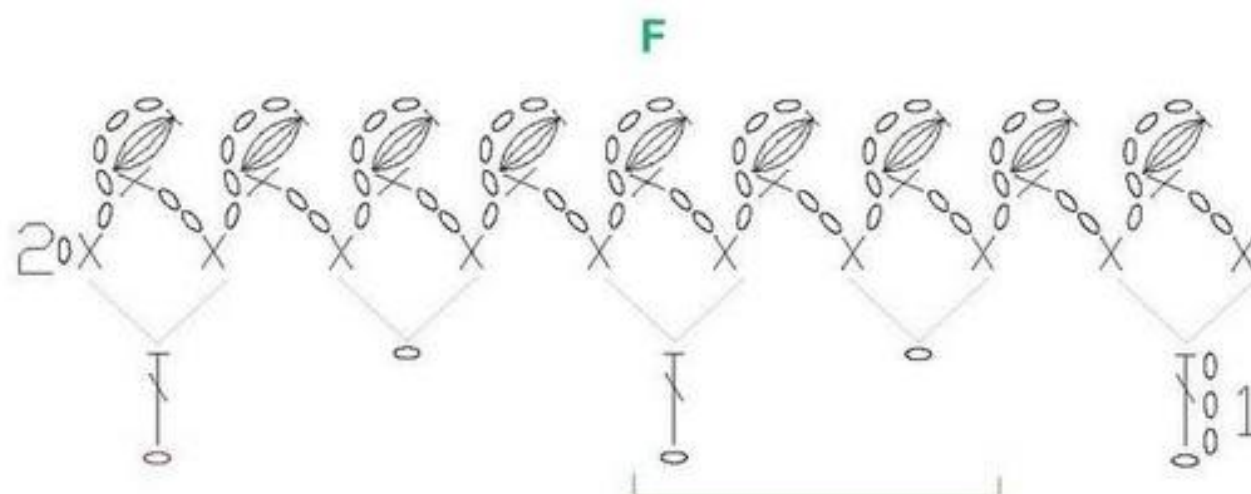

65 - Bouquet of Roses

See diagrams on p.85 - 88.

The bouquet consist of pink rose and bud, yellow rose and bud, red rose and bud, 3 bells, 4 big liaves, 4 small leaves and 4 stems.

For pink rose make chain foundation of 76ch. Work with diagram A: Part 1 - 11 times, Part 2 - 5 times, Part 3 - 4 times and Part 4 - 4 times. Turn and work with diagram B last row. The stamens work with yellow yarn and diagram C.

For yellow rose chain foundation of 52ch. Work with diagram A: Part 1 - 10 times, Part 2 - 6 times, in last chain work d.tr/tr. Turn and work with diagram B last row.

For red rose make chain foundation of 36ch. Work with diagram A: Part 1 - 11 times, in last chain work d.tr/tr. Turn and work with diagram B last row.

All buds work with diagrams D (pink, yellow, red yarn) and E (green yarn).

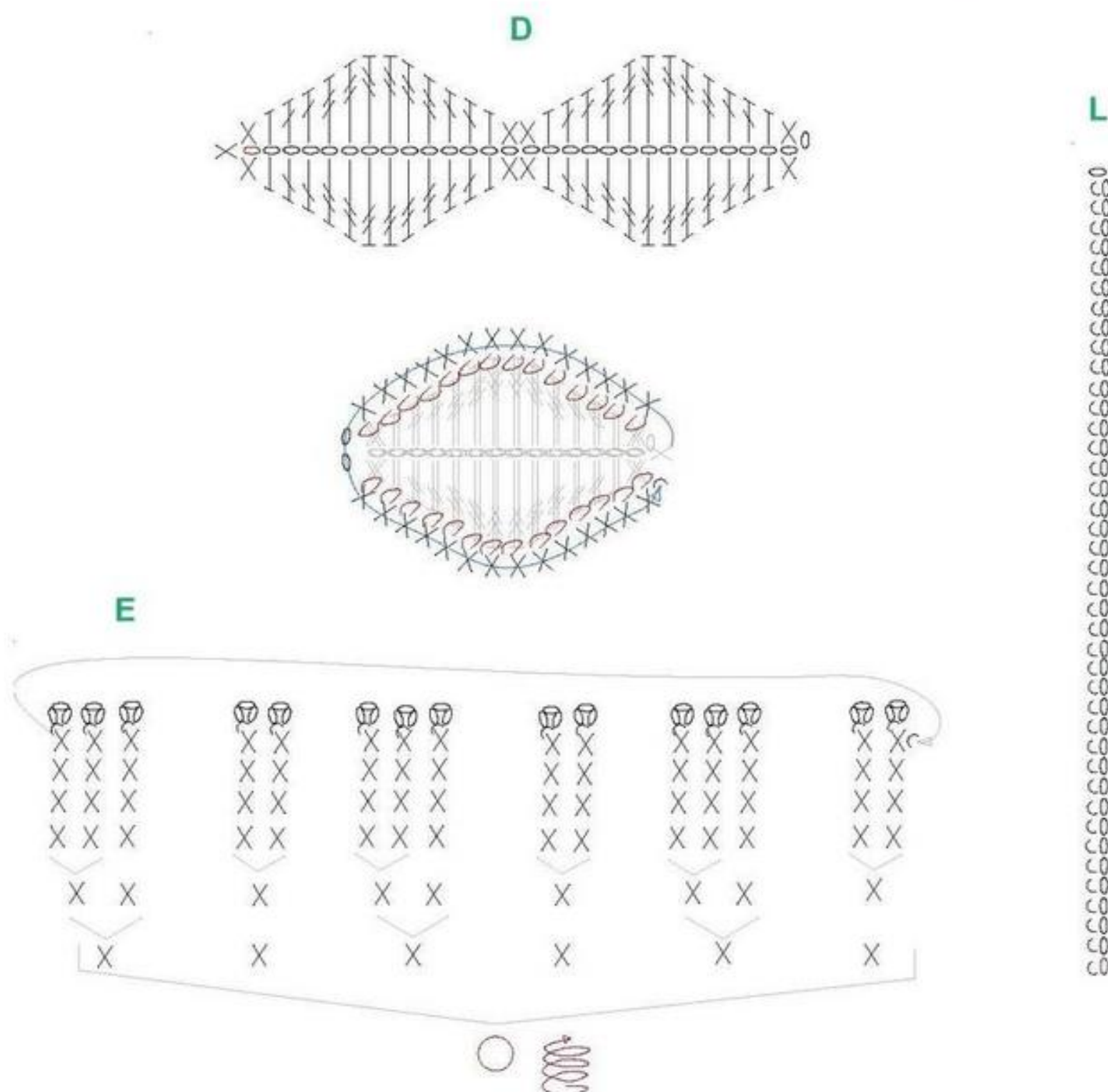
Bud's petal work with diagram D, then fold petal strip in two and work dc/sc at once in two edges. When the bud's edge will be closed in half, fill the bud with absorbent cotton and continue work dc/sc to the end.

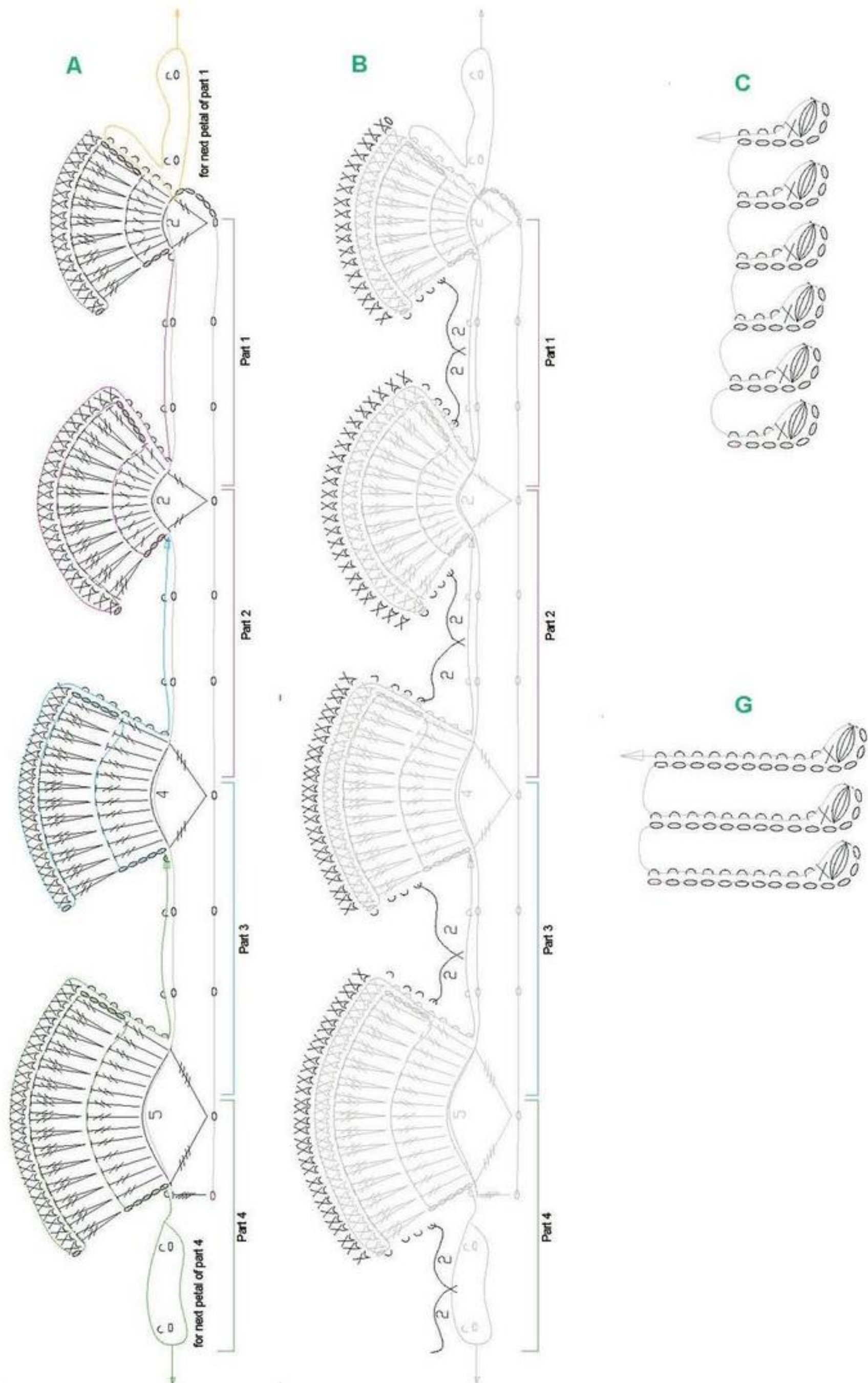
The bells work with white yarn and diagram F. Stamens work with yellow yarn and diagram G. Wrap the absorbent cotton around stamens and fill bells.

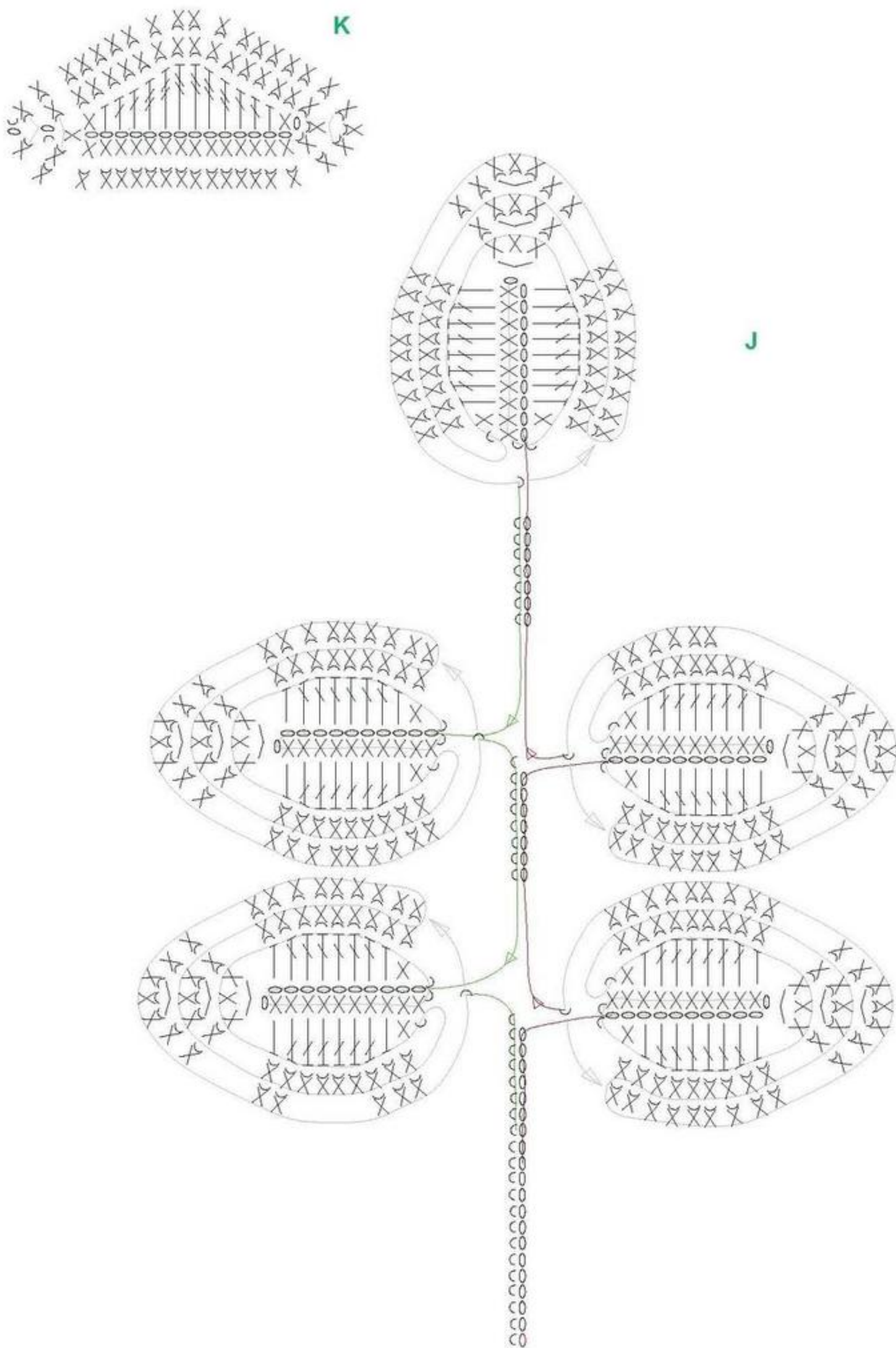

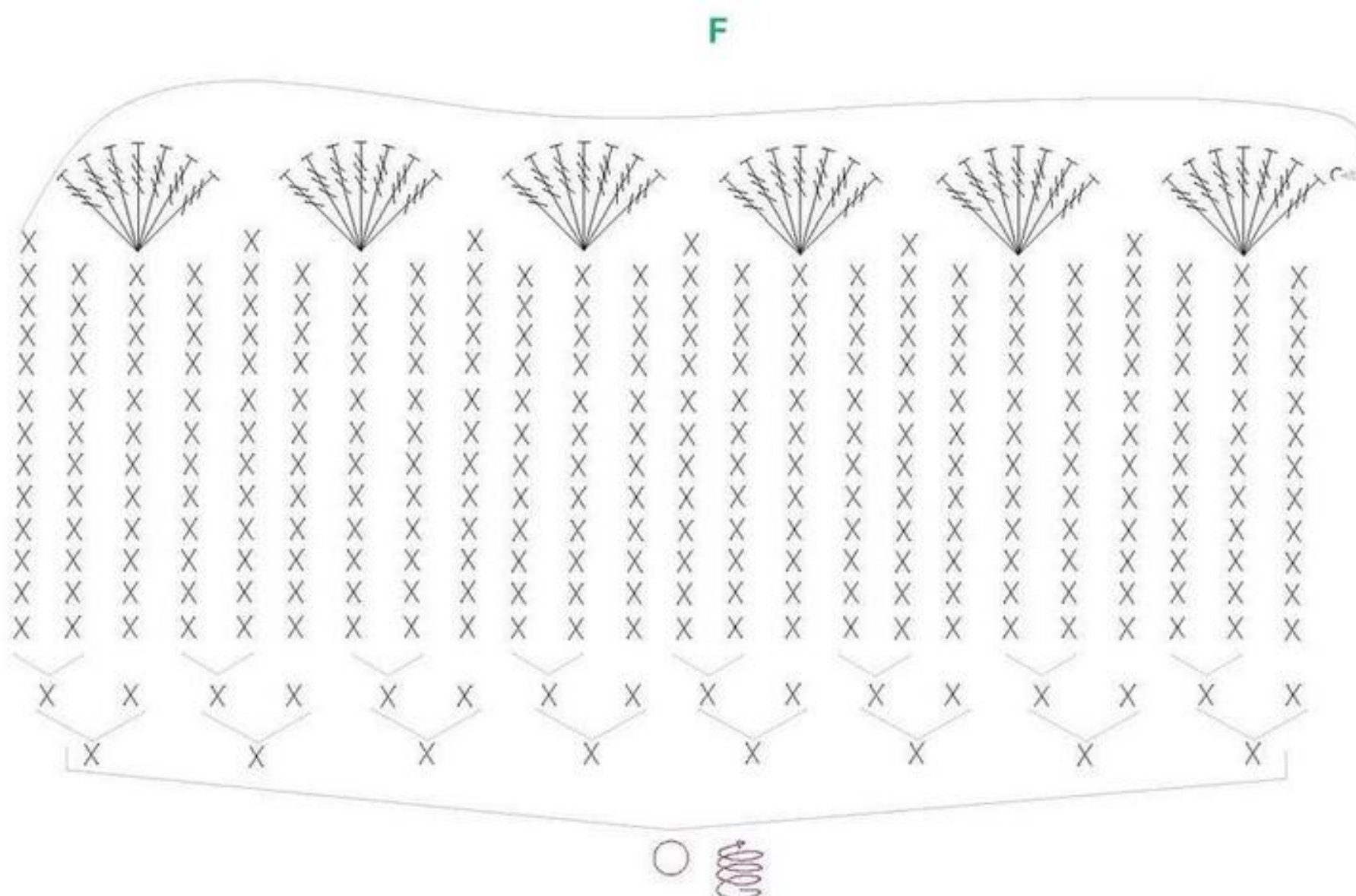
The work begins with chain foundation of 20ch for steam + 11ch for first leaf. Work dc/sc in second ch from hook and 8dc/sc in next stitches, 1 dc/sc - 2 sl.st in last ch of leaf chain foundation, turn and work on opposite side. Skip one st, dc/sc, h.tr/h.dc, 6tr/dc, h.tr/h.dc, 3dc/sc in first ch of leaf chain foundation; work on opposite side: h.tr/h.dc, 6tr/dc, h.tr/h.dc, 1dc/sc, sl.st, turn. In next row work dc/sc in back loop of each stitch and 3dc/sc in top of leaf, turn and work next row in this way (see diagram). At the end work sl.st in first dc/sc. For next leaf make chain foundation of 7 ch for stem and 11 ch for leaf, make next leaves like first. After you get 3 leaves, work on opposite side of branch with sl.st and make leaves.

Work small leaves with light green yarn and diagram K, stems with diagram L.









66 - Bouquet of red and pink Poppies

See diagrams on p.89 - 92.

The bouquet consist of 2 big pink and red poppies, small red poppy, branch with pink small poppy, pink and green buds, branch with red and green buds, pink bud with stem, 8 white flowers, 3 small stems, 2 leaves.

The petals of big poppies work with diagram A (pink and red yarn), middle part with diagram B and yellow yarn, stamens with diagram C and black yarn. For stamens work chain foundation of 10 ch. tr/dc in 4th ch from hook, * 1ch tr/dc in next st, repeat from* 5 times. Stamens twist into spiral and sew back to hold spiral in place.

For petals of small red poppy work with diagram D, stamens - with diagram C and black yarn, sepals - with diagram E and green yarn. For stamens work 6ch foundation and work with diagram. Twist stamens into spiral and sew back to hold spiral in place.

Branch with pink small poppy, pink and green buds: pink small poppy work like small red poppy, pink bud with diagram E and F, green bud with diagram G, stem with diagram J. Bud's petal work with diagram F, then fold petal strip in two and work dc/sc at once in two edges. When the edges will be closed in half, fill the bud with absorbent cotton and continue work dc/sc to the end.

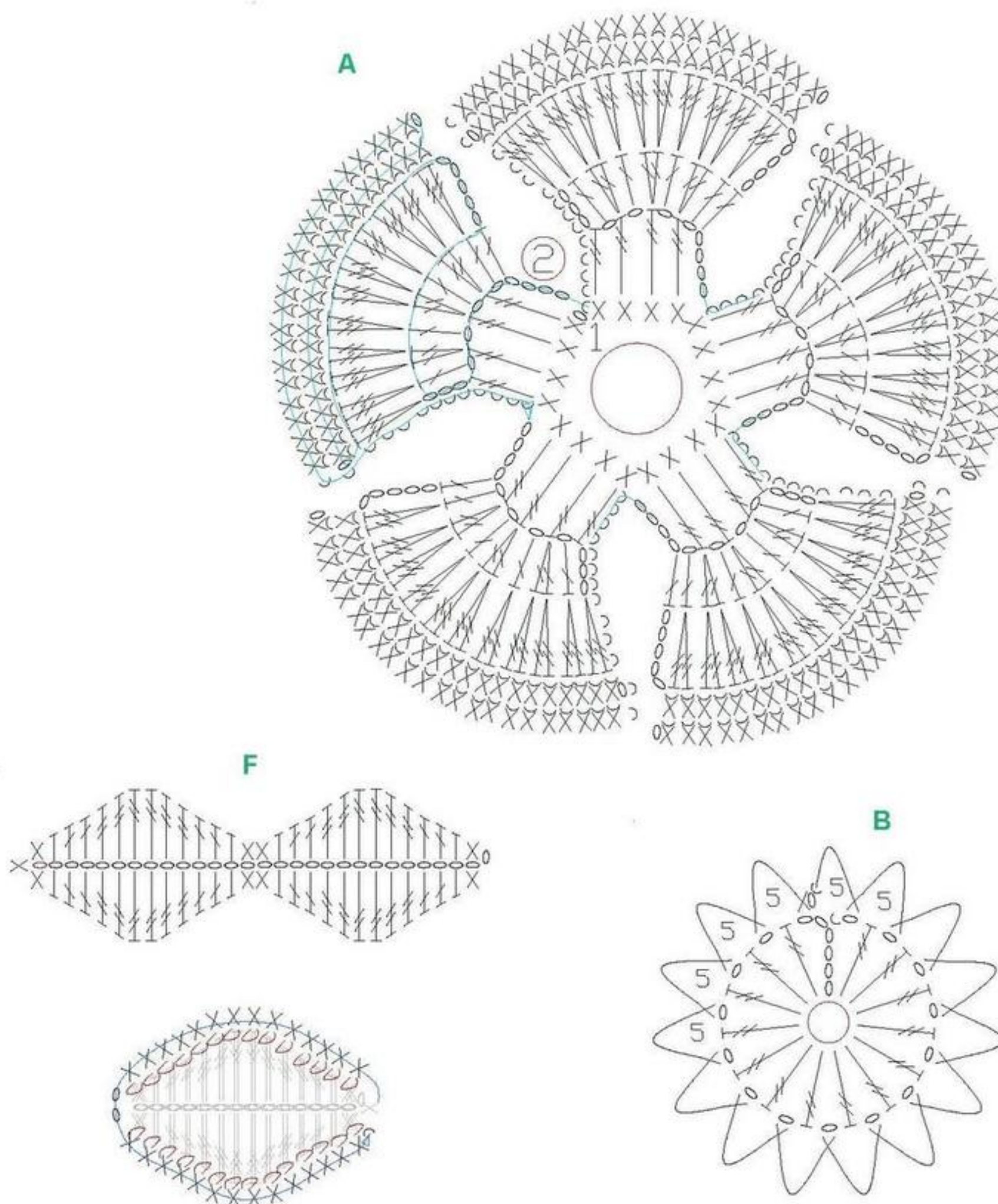
Work bud's sepal with diagram E and stem with diagram J, connect stem to sepals and green bud by dc/sc.

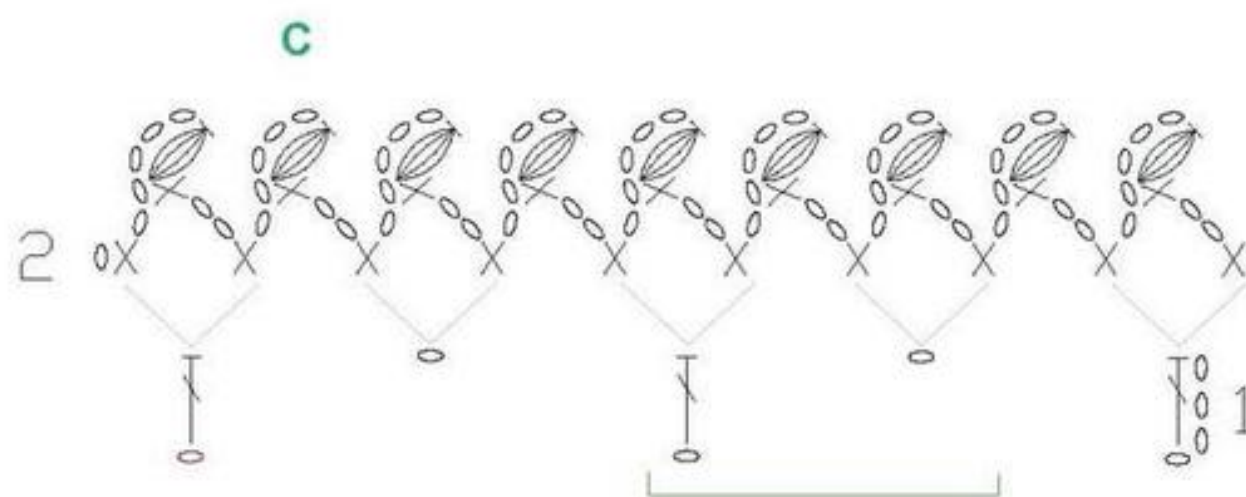
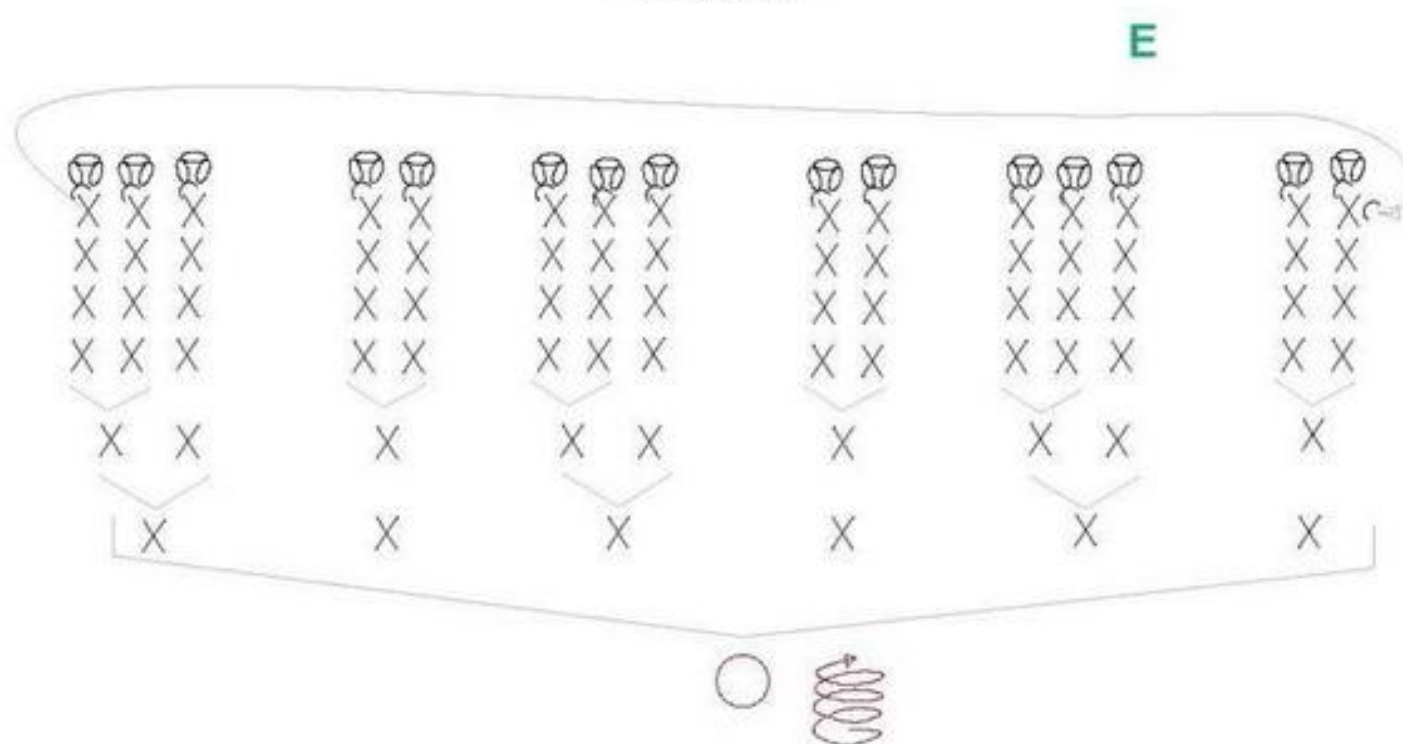
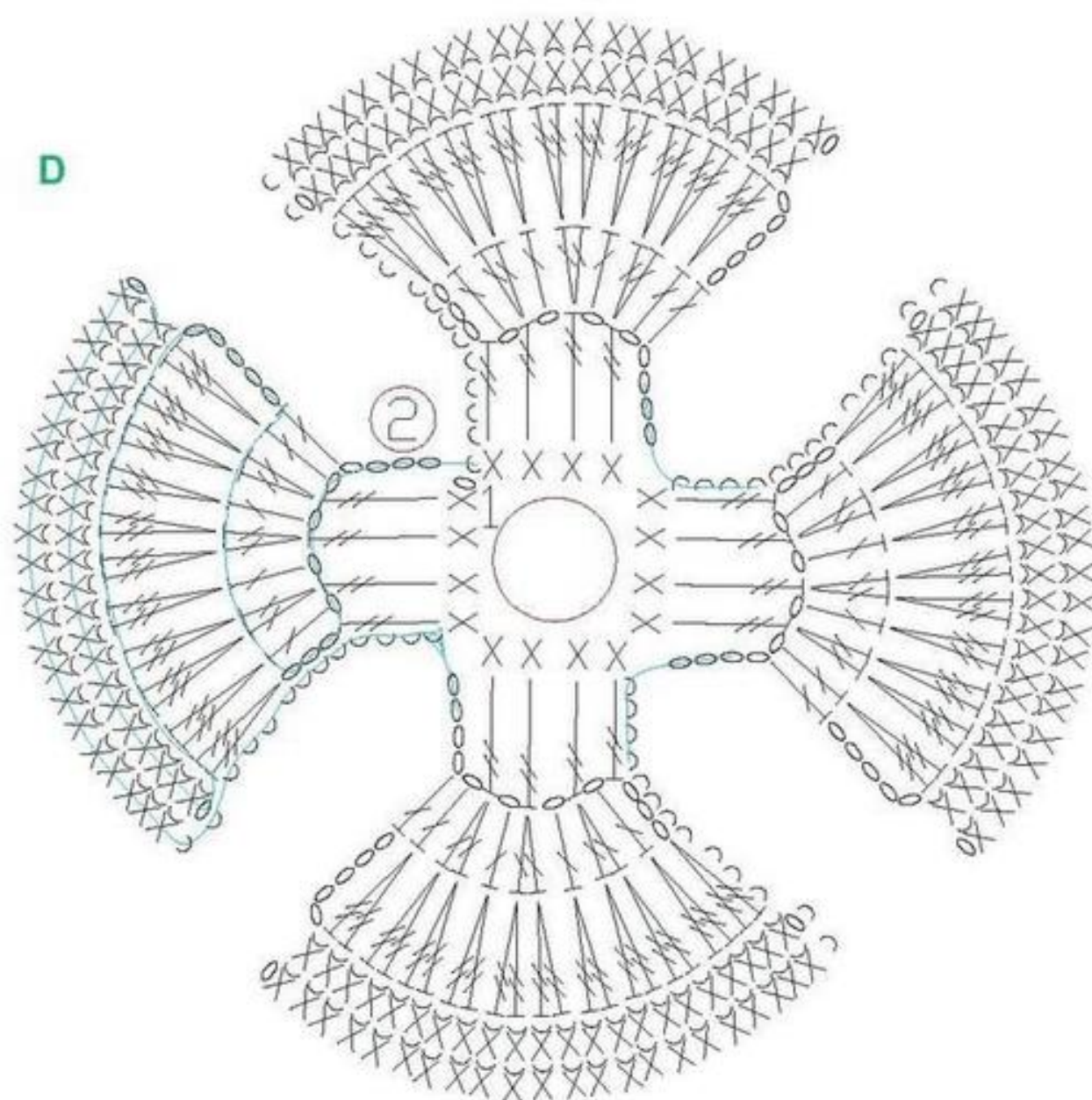

Flower from puffs

In some MYpicot patterns I use technique making the flower from clusters or puffs stitches in two rows. They have one principle and below we learned how it's crochet.



Step 1

Work given numbers of ch, in this case 5 ch.



Step 2

Work 1 **incomplete** puff stitch of 2 h.tr/h.dc in 5th ch from hook.



Step 3

Work 1 **incomplete** puff stitch of 4 h.tr/h.dc in next stitch, 3 st skip and work 1 **incomplete** puff stitch in next stitch.



Step 4

Yran over and draw through all loops on hook.



Step 5

Make 5ch.



Step 6

Work puff stitch in top of previous 3 puffs and make given stitches.



Step 7

In next row, work given stitches and puff stitch of 4 h.tr/h.dc in top of 4 puffs below.



Step 8

Work 3 ch, puff stitch in the same space and given stitches.

Long Loop Stitch

These beautiful stitches makes a lot of opportunities for its use in patterns. It is very simple, but there are some nuances for the good result.

The yarn used again is not always suitable for this stitch. It is nessesary to use a smooth yarn and make loops the same length for pattern's carefully look.



Step 1

Yarn over hook.



Step 2

Insert hook into next stitch and draw yarn up 0,5 – 1 cm.



Step 3

Repeat 3 times until you have 8 loops on hook.



Step 4

Yarn over hook and draw through 8 loops (2 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through 2 loops.



Step 5

Insert hook into middle between loops.



Step 6

Yarn over and work dc/sc.



Step 6

Work more two dc/sc in the same space.

Long Loop Stitch with arch of 5ch



Step 1

Insert hook into next stitch and draw yarn up 0,5 – 1 cm, *yarn over hook, insert hook into next stitch and draw yarn up, repeat from*3 times.



Step 2

Yarn over hook and draw through 8 loops (2 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through 2 loops. Insert hook into middle between loops and work 1dc/sc.ps on hook), yarn over and draw through 2 loops. Insert hook into middle between loops and work 1dc/sc.



Step 3

Make 5 ch.



Steps 4 - 5

Work dc/sc into middle space of stitch.



Flower stitches

This is a useful technique makes the flowers without cutting threads. You can crochet in your pattern so many small flowers as you want. Below we will learn how to crochet flowers with different numbers of petals. All of them works with the same principle: round of petals makes around of base. The base consists of tr/dc - 1ch - h.tr/h.dc in the same space and forms a triangle.

The small flower of 4 petals



Step 1

Work given stitches, skip 1 st, **tr/dc - 1ch - h.tr/h.dc** in the same stitch. This is the base of flower.



Step 2

Insert hook into space of base and work dc/sc.



Step 3

Work 3 ch and yarn over 2 times.

Work d.tr/tr in base's space.



Step 5

Work 2 d.tr/tr in base's space and 3 ch.



Step 6

Insert hook into stitch from back to front.

Work dc/sc.

Work 3ch and 3 d.tr/tr in the same stitch, 3ch.

Insert hook around base's tr/dc and work dc/sc.
