

Abbreviations

ss – slip stitch

sc – single crochet

dc – double crochet

hdc – half double crochet

tc – triple crochet

chsp – chain space

1. Solid Granny Square Pattern

Start with a **magic ring** or a "fake" magic ring.

Note: When you see "corner," work *2 dc + chain 2 + 2 dc* into the **chsp**.

Round 1

chain 5,

3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc, ch 2,

2 dc, ss into 3rd chain.

Round 2

Chain 3, corner, 3 dc, corner, 3 dc, corner, 3 dc, corner, 2 dc,

ss into 3rd chain.

Round 3

Chain 3, 2 dc, corner, 7 dc, corner, 7 dc, corner, 7 dc, corner, 4 dc,

ss into 3rd chain.

Round 4

Chain 3, 4 dc, corner, 11 dc, corner, 11 dc, corner, 11 dc, corner, 6 dc,

ss into 3rd chain.

Round 5 forwards

Begin each round with chain 3.

1 dc in every stitch along the sides.

At each chsp, insert the steps for a corner.

Repeat until you've gone around, then ss into the 3rd chain to finish the round.

2. Bow Granny Square Pattern

This is simply a **solid granny square** with a **crochet bow** sewn or glued onto the center.

Bow – First Piece (Main Bow Loops)

Chain 25

Top side:

sc, 2 hdc, 2 dc, 2 tc, 2 dc, 2 hdc, 2 ss, 2 hdc, 2 dc, 2 tc, 2 dc, 2 hdc, 3 sc in last chain

Bottom side:

2 hdc, 2 dc, 2 tc, 2 dc, 2 hdc, 2 ss, 2 hdc, 2 dc, 2 tc, 2 dc, 2 hdc, 2 sc in last chain
ss into the 1st stitch and fasten off

Bow – Second Piece (Bow Center Wrap)

Chain 15

sc, hdc, dc, tc, dc, hdc, sc, ss, hdc, dc, tc, dc, hdc, sc

Fasten off

assembly

Wrap the second piece around the center of the first to form the bow.

Secure it with yarn or glue.

Sew or glue the finished bow onto the center of your solid granny square.
