

## Pattern Details

Skill Level: Easy (Level 2)

Size: Medium

Circumference at bottom edge: 46 inches (117 cm)

Length: 17½ inches (44.5 cm)

Gauge: 3 shells and 5 rows = 4 inches (10 cm)

### Abbreviations

ch = chain

dc = double crochet

tr = treble (triple) crochet

ss = slip stitch

shell = 3 dc in same space

point shell = (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in same space

## Full Granny Poncho Pattern

Start with Color A

Foundation: Ch 84. Join with ss to form a circle (neck opening).

Round 1: Neck Tie Round

Ch 3, dc in next 2 ch, ch 1, skip 1 ch, (dc in next 3 ch, ch 1, skip 1 ch) repeat 4 times. In next ch: (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) for point shell.

Continue: (dc in next 3 ch, ch 1, skip 1 ch) 10 times, then another point shell, followed by (dc in next 3 ch, ch 1, skip 1 ch) 5 times. Join with ss to top of starting ch-3.

Round 2

Slip stitch to next ch-1 space. Ch 3, 2 dc in same space. (Shell in next ch-1 space, ch 1) 4 times.

Point shell in point shell space. Continue with (shell in ch-1 space, ch 1) 11 times, then another point shell, and 6 more shells across. Join with ss.

Round 3

Repeat as above, increasing to 12 shells between point shells.

Rounds 4–7

Continue in established pattern, increasing 1 shell per side each round. End Round 7 with 16 shells between point shells.

Fasten off Color A.

## Color Changes and Expansion

- **Rounds 8–14 (Color B):** Join in first ch-1 space of Round 7. Work 7 rounds as established (23 shells per side). Fasten off.

- **Rounds 15–19 (Color C):** Work 5 more rounds in established pattern (28 shells per side). Fasten off.
- **Rounds 20–22 (Color D):** Final 3 rounds, ending with 31 shells per side. Fasten off.

### **Neck Trim**

Turn the piece and work along the starting chain:

**Round 1:** Join Color A in last chain. Ch 3, 2 dc in same ch, skip 3 ch, (*shell in next ch, ch 1, skip 3*) 4 times. Shell in same ch as previous point shell, then continue (*shell, ch 1, skip 3*) around. Join with ss.

**Round 2:** Slip stitch to next ch-1 space. Ch 3, 2 dc in same space. (*Shell, ch 1*) in each ch-1 space around. Join with ss. Fasten off.

### **Neck Tie and Flowers**

#### **Neck Tie (Color D):**


Ch 151, ss in second ch from hook and each ch across. Fasten off.

#### **Flowers (Make 2, Color A):**

Ch 3, ss into first ch to form a ring. (*Ch 4, tr, ss*) in ring 5 times. Ch 1, fasten off. Pull the neck tie through each flower center and sew flowers to both tie ends.

### **Final Notes**

This **granny poncho pattern** is the perfect mix of comfort, style, and handmade charm. With soft textures and simple construction, it's a satisfying project that works up beautifully whether you're crocheting for yourself or creating heartfelt gifts.

 **Tip:** Experiment with color gradients or leftover yarn to create a vibrant patchwork effect. This design is versatile enough to handle bold shades or soft neutrals.
