Stitches Used & Abbreviations (US Terms):

- ch = chain
- dc = double crochet
- sk = skip
- sp = space
- REP = repeat

Notes:

- This stitch pattern is worked in multiples of 5 + 4 chains.
- It is a 1-row repeat pattern (Row 3 is the repeat).
- Creates a beautiful, lacy yet sturdy fabric suitable for many projects.

Written Instructions:

Foundation Chain:

- Start with ch 24 (or any multiple of 5 + 4).

Row 1:

- Sk 5 ch (counts as 1 dc and ch-2 space).
- (3 dc, ch 2, 1 dc all into the next ch).
- * Sk 4 ch, (3 dc, ch 2, 1 dc all into the next ch) *.
- Repeat from * to * until you have 3 ch left.
- Sk 2 ch, 1 dc into the last ch.

Row 2:

- Turn, ch 3 (counts as 1 dc).
- (3 dc, ch 2, 1 dc all into the ch-2 space).
- Repeat into each ch-2 space across.
- End with 1 dc into the fifth chain that was skipped on Row 1.

Row 3:

- Turn, ch 3 (counts as 1 dc).
- (3 dc, ch 2, 1 dc all into the ch-2 space).
- Repeat into each ch-2 space across.
- End with 1 dc into the third chain.

Repeat Row 3 until your project reaches your desired length.

Tips for Success:

- Keep your foundation chain loose to avoid tension issues.
- Blocking enhances stitch definition.
- Variegated yarns highlight the stitch pattern beautifully.
